PAC VOLLEYBALL 2009 - Week 7 Conference Notes

TOMCATS TAKE PAC PAIR: The 2009 PAC volleyball race tightened significantly this weekend following a key conference tri-match hosted by Thiel ... The host Tomcats moved into the race for the top seed in the PAC Tournament with a pair of victories over both Westminster (3-1) and Thomas More (3-2), both of whom were previously unbeaten in PAC play prior to Saturday ... The Saints now lead the conference at 8-1, with Thiel (7-1) and the 2008 PAC champion Titans (7-2) close behind.

NEWS & NOTES: Senior **Abbey Kiger** became the all-time kills leader at Thiel on Saturday, as she now has 1,195 in her Tomcat career ... After sweeping W&J during the week, Saint Vincent went 3-1 at the Gallaudet Invitational, losing to the host school in the title match which broke the Bearcats' 10-match win streak ... Senior MH **Samantha Butler** had 27 kills, 13 blocks and six assists during a 2-1 week for W&J ... Sophomore OH **Brandi Corbello** posted 76 kills and 41 digs during a 5-2 week for Thomas More.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: With a conference win over Chatham last week, Bethany has its most PAC wins since the 2001 season ... Sophomore MB **Lindsay Speidel** posted a career-high 17 kills in a four-set PAC win over Waynesburg ... **Brianna Mixter** had a career-high 33 digs for Geneva in a five-set win over Roberts Wesleyan ... **Carly Smithyman** had 104 assists last week for 1-3 Waynesburg ... Grove City went 0-3 on the week, with **Anna McCurdy** posting nine kills in a loss to NAIA Roberts Wesleyan.

Bethany Bison (11-11, 3-7 PAC)



Bethany concluded their busiest stretch of the year with setbacks to PAC front-runners Thiel and Westminster before nearly sweeping a tri-match at W&J ... Freshman S **Jessica Zavatchen** passed out 22 assists and brought up 12 digs against Thiel ... **Nancy Hitt** posted a team-high 10 kills and **Megan Hoffman** served 4 aces at Westminster ... In the Chatham win, 11 different Bison had kills and BC served 16 aces, including 4 each from **Megan** and **Tiffany Hoffman** and **Alyssa Schrecengost**, while Zavatchen had 24 assists and 3 blocks ... **Lauren Goodwill** had 11 kills, Zavatchen passed out 41 assists and Tiffany Hoffman totaled 25 digs in the five-set loss against W&J.

Chatham Cougars (1-19, 0-9 PAC)



Chatham lost all three of its Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) contests this week, beginning with Geneva College and ending with Thomas More College ... The Cougars were defeated by NCAA Division III provisional member Geneva at home in four sets, then traveled to Washington & Jefferson College over the weekend to compete in a tri-match against the Presidents and Bethany College ... The team lost both matches in three sets and rounded out the weekend of conference play by losing to Thomas More in three sets at home.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (14-5)



After dropping its second match of the season against Thomas More to start the week, the GTs won three straight including a pair of five-game matches against Chatham and Roberts Wesleyan ... Vs. Chatham on Thursday night, **Paige Banyas** recorded a season high 29 digs ... **Kristland McCracken** led the offense with 10 kills ... Saturday, Geneva cruised past Grove City in three sets before getting its first NCCAA test against Roberts Wesleyan ... After dropping the first two games, the Golden Tornadoes stormed back to take the next three games and record a victory in the first of three matches against NCCAA competition that will determine Geneva's national tournament hopes.

Grove City Wolverines (6-15, 3-4 PAC)



The Wolverines dropped three home matches this weekend ... Friday night, Thomas More swept Grove City ... Saturday, Roberts Wesleyan and Geneva swept the Wolverines in the GCC Arena ... Sophomore **Anna McCurdy** had nine kills against Roberts Wesleyan while **Jodi Barry**'s seven kills led Grove City against Geneva ... At 3-4 in conference play, the Wolverines face a pair of pivotal matches this week ... Thursday, Grove City plays at Waynesburg ... Saturday, Chatham visits Grove City ... The Wolverines own 3-0 wins over each of those squads earlier this season.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (17-7)



The Lady Bearcats continued their strong play, going 4-1 on the week ... In Wednesday's three-set win over W&J, **Diana Petrovich** and **Taylor Guido** each posted nine kills, while **Natalie Hozak** had a match-high 15 digs to go with three aces ... SVC then participated in the two-day Gallaudet University tournament on Fri-Sat, going 3-1 and taking second place ... Petrovich and Guido were both named to the all-tournament team, as the former had 51 kills in the four matches and the latter 36 ... **Dawn Timko** also had a strong weekend for the Green & Gold, tallying 30 kills and 11 blocks.

Thiel Tomcats (16-7, 7-1 PAC)



It was a historic afternoon in Beeghly Gymnasium Saturday, as the Tomcats swept a tri-match featuring the PAC's top two teams and gained a new all-time kills leader in **Abbey Kiger**... Thiel laid the first conference losses of the season on both Thomas More and Westminster, while Kiger fired 17 kills to break the College record for career kills with 1,195... The victory over Westminster was paced by freshmen **Kelly Barzak** and **Alyssa Chine** with 13 and 11 kills, respectively... **Megan Kay** registered a team-high 26 digs... In a thrilling five-set match, Thiel outlasted Thomas More, 3-2 ... The trio of Kay, Barzak, and **Megg Andrews** led the offense, racking up 12, 11, and nine kills, respectively.

Thomas More Saints (18-8, 8-1 PAC)



The Saints had a 5-2 week as they defeated Geneva, Waynesburg, Grove City, Westminster and Chatham, but fell in five games to both Thiel and Carnegie Mellon ... Sophomore OH **Brandi Corbello** led the team in kills with 76 and added 41 digs and five service aces ... Defensively, freshman DS **Danielle Beckenhaupt** led the team with 97 digs and also had five service aces, while sophomore S **Emily Bohman** had 181 assists and 52 digs and a team-high nine service aces last week for the Saints.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (10-9, 5-2 PAC)



W&J, which sits in fourth place in the PAC standings, won two of three league matches last week ... The Presidents dropped a 3-0 decision against Saint Vincent on October 7th, before sweeping a PAC tri-match with Bethany and Chatham Saturday at the Henry Memorial Center ... Senior **Monika Linden** had 16 kills in the win over the Bison, while senior **Stephanie Lucsko** collected 10 kills for the second straight match in the 3-0 victory over Chatham ... The Red & Black return to the Henry Memorial Center Tuesday evening for a 7 p.m. contest with PAC-rival Waynesburg, before traveling to Kentucky on Thursday evening for a key conference match against Thomas More at 7 p.m.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-15, 1-8 PAC)



Waynesburg snapped a nine-match losing streak this past Saturday with a 3-1 victory over La Roche during a tri-match at Franciscan University ... Sophomore OH **Carly Schubert** led the attack against the Red Hawks with 12 kills, while freshman S **Carly Smithyman** racked up 31 assists in the victory ... Junior LIB **Rachell Storm** recorded 19 of her 87 digs on the week in the victory ... On the week, **Jordan Barton** rolled up a team-high 37 kills, while Schubert chipped in 34.

Westminster Titans (8-15, 7-2 PAC)



Westminster posted a 2-2 record in four PAC matches last week, winning two weekday home matches over Waynesburg, 3-1, Tuesday and Bethany, 3-1, Thursday ... The Titans then lost two at Thiel Saturday, losing 3-1 to Thiel and 3-0 to Thomas More ... Westminster has won 22 straight in the PAC at home dating back to Sept. 21, 2006, but with the two road PAC losses over the weekend, Westminster has lost two PAC matches in a season for the first time since 2006 after the Titans posted 13-1 league records in 2007 and 2008 ... Sophomore MB **Lindsay Speidel** led the Titans with 3.2 kills per set, while sophomore S **Jessie Szakacs** paced Westminster with 9.53 assists per set.
