# PAC VOLLEYBALL 2009 - Week 7 Conference Notes

**TOMCATS TAKE PAC PAIR:** The 2009 PAC volleyball race tightened significantly this weekend following a key conference tri-match hosted by Thiel ... The host Tomcats moved into the race for the top seed in the PAC Tournament with a pair of victories over both Westminster (3-1) and Thomas More (3-2), both of whom were previously unbeaten in PAC play prior to Saturday ... The Saints now lead the conference at 8-1, with Thiel (7-1) and the 2008 PAC champion Titans (7-2) close behind.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Senior **Abbey Kiger** became the all-time kills leader at Thiel on Saturday, ash she now has 1,195 in her Tomcat career ... After sweeping W&J during the week, Saint Vincent went 3-1 at the Gallaudet Invitational, losing to the host school in the title match which broke the Bearcats' 10-match win streak ... Senior MH **Samantha Butler** had 27 kills, 13 blocks and six assists during a 2-1 week for W&J ... Sophomore OH **Brandi Corbello** posted 76 kills and 41 digs during a 5-2 week for Thomas More. AROUND THE LEAGUE: With a conference win over Chatham last week, Bethany has its most PAC wins since the 2001 season ... Sophomore MB Lindsay Speidel posted a career-high 17 kills in a four-set PAC win over Waynesburg ... Brianna Mixter had a career-high 33 digs for Geneva in a five-set win over Roberts Wesleyan ... Carly Smithyman had 104 assists last week for 1-3 Waynesburg ... Grove City went 0-3 on the week, with Anna McCurdy posting nine kills in a loss to NAIA Roberts Wesleyan.

# Bethany Bison (11-11, 3-7 PAC)

Bethany concluded their busiest stretch of the year with setbacks to PAC front-runners Thiel and Westminster before nearly sweeping a tri-match at

W&J ... Freshman S Jessica Zavatchen passed out 22 assists and brought up 12 digs against Thiel ... Nancy Hitt posted a team-high 10 kills and Megan Hoffman served 4 aces at Westminster ... In the Chatham win, 11 different Bison had kills and BC served 16 aces, including 4 each from Megan and Tiffany Hoffman and Alyssa Schrecengost, while Zavatchen had 24 assists and 3 blocks ... Lauren Goodwill had 11 kills, Zavatchen passed out 41 assists and Tiffany Hoffman totaled 25 digs in the five-set loss against W&J.

# Geneva Golden Tornadoes (14-5)



After dropping its second match of the season against Thomas More to start the week, the GTs won three straight including a pair of five-game matches against Chatham and Roberts Wesleyan

... Vs. Chatham on Thursday night, **Paige Banyas** recorded a season high 29 digs ... **Kristland McCracken** led the offense with 10 kills ... Saturday, Geneva cruised past Grove City in three sets before getting its first NCCAA test against Roberts Wesleyan ... After dropping the first two games, the Golden Tornadoes stormed back to take the next three games and record a victory in the first of three matches against NCCAA competition that will determine Geneva's national tournament hopes.

# Saint Vincent Bearcats (17-7)

The Lady Bearcats continued their strong play, going 4-1 on the week ... In Wednesday's three-set win over W&J, **Diana Petrovich** and **Taylor Guido** each posted nine kills, while **Natalie Hozak** had a match-high 15
