Cooper earned PAC laurels for the second consecutive week after leading the Titans to three 3-0 sweeps of PAC opponents, lifting Westminster into sole possession of first place in the confer-



ence standings. She averaged 4.22 kills per game in the three matches, including team-high totals of 16 kills against Grove City and 15 vs. Geneva, while adding seven total blocks for the week.

Bethany matched its win total from last season by sandwiching a pair of victories around a loss at Westminster ... BC claimed their second win of the

year over Chatham Monday in three games ... Senior Lauren Spegal pounded 21 kills, while junior Kim McKay had 34 assists and sophomore Rachael Dunham brought up 19 digs ... Spegal also led BC in a win over LaRoche Friday during Homecoming ... She had 18 kills to move her career total to 1,190, leaving her eight away from passing Kelly Sitko (1,197) for the all-time record at Bethany ... Also vs. LaRoche, McKay gave out 27 assists and Dunham amassed 17 digs for her fifth straight 10+ dig match.
