LAKIA GORDON **Washington & Jefferson College**

5-8 junior outside hitter Farrell, Pa./Farrell H.S.

PAC VOLLEYBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 0-3 last week, falling twice on the road and once at home ... Despite dropping all three matches, the Bison hung tough with each team ... The squad started the week with a home match against Grove City and lost 3-0 (27-30, 24-30, 24-30) ... The Bison then faced Waynesburg and Westminster on the road to end the week and fell by scores of 3-0 (18-30, 27-30, 25-30) and 3-1 (30-18, 23-30, 20-30, 25-30) ... Lauren Spegal had nine kills and 19 digs against Grove City. while Angelina Allen had seven kills and 17 digs ... Against Waynesburg, Linzy Turner led the team with 14 digs and Spegal recorded 10 kills and nine digs, along with the team's only two service aces of the match.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson split a pair of conference matches this past week as it swept Westminster in New Wilmington on Tuesday, but dropped a 3-2 decision at Grove City on Saturday ... Junior outside hitter Lakia Gordon led the way with 21 kills in the 3-0 victory at Westminster ... Senior outside hitter Jerica Lamens added 10 kills and 16 digs ... Sophomore setter Jamie Gullen chipped in with 21 assists, six kills and three blocks, while junior libero Anne Reynolds recorded 23 digs and four service aces ... Junior middle hitter Rebecca Fletcher had a team-high 17 kills in the loss to the Wolverines ... Gordon added 14 kills, while Lamens racked up 12 kills and 13 digs ... Gullen notched a triple-double with 39 assists, 15 digs and 10 kills.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City ran its PAC win streak to four with a pair of wins last week ... Carlie Roberts helped lead Grove City to a sweep at Bethany with 13 kills and five blocks while fellow sophomore Kelly Tinney had seven kills ... Saturday, the Wolverines earned its first five-game victory of the season by rallying past W&J ... Tinney had a team-high 17 kills while Roberts added a 15-kill, 13-block doubledouble ... Kate DiMarco, in her final home match, added 12 kills in the victory over the Presidents ... Sophomore Allison Cummings added seven blocks in the win ... Tinney posted 13 kills in a narrow loss to Slippery Rock ... Senior Melissa Lawton recorded 16 digs against SRU.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College volleyball team continues to rack up victories over PAC struggling before heading off to weekend tournaments ... The Jackets posted back-to-back 3-0 victories over Thiel and Bethany before traveling to the Calvin Tournament where they posted a 1-3 record ... The lone win came against Defiance College, when **Brittany Morrow** and **Kimberly Wilson** recorded 16 and 10 kills, respectively ... Wilson also had 18 digs in the match.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 0-for-4 last week ... After falling 1-3 at Waynesburg on Tuesday and 1-3 in their home finale on Thursday to Westminster, they dropped both matches Saturday at Urbana ... The Tomcats fell to host Urbana 0-3 to open the day and lost to Mountain State 0-3 to finish it ... Senior MH **Jessica Erickson** averaged 11.3 kills and 3.0 blocks per match ... Erickson also became the school's all-time blocks leader with 352.

Westminster Titans

Westminster won two of three matches against PAC foes last week, falling in straight sets to W&J before posting fourset wins at Thiel and vs. Bethany ... Junior OH Erin Hinks led the Lady Titan offense with 12 kills in the W&J loss, followed by sophomore Rachael Cooper and freshman Jessica Cooper with eight kills apiece ... Sophomore MH Katie McDermott posted seven total blocks (one solo, six assisted) ... At Thiel, Hinks and McDermott posted 16 and 13 kills, respectively, while each added three aces ... Senior MH Sarah McKain led the squad with four solo blocks ... Hinks led four players with double-digit kill totals vs. Bethany with 16 ... Rachael Cooper added 30 assists and a team-high 20 digs against the Bison.
