#### PAC VOLLEYBALL 2010 - Week 9 Conference Notes

TMC ON TOP: The stage is set for the 2010 PAC Volleyball Championship Tournament, with Westminster and Saint Vincent hosting first round matches Tuesday night while drefending PAC champion Thomas More will host the semifinals and finals on Friday and Saturday in Crestview Hills, Ky. ... The Saints clinched a perfect 16-0 league record and the 2010 PAC regular season title by posting three straightset wins on the road this weekend, including 3-0 victories over #2 Thiel and #3 Westminster.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More is riding a season-best 15 match winning streak after going 3-0 last week, as junior OH Brandi Corbello posted 21 kills, five aces, 16 digs and four blocks ... Geneva closed the regular season with a 3-0 week to finish 26-5, the best record in the program's history ... The GTs are still awaiting word on a possible NCCAA national tournament bid ... With 25 digs vs. Westminster, Tiffany Hoffman of Bethany surpassed the 1,500-career dig plateau Thursday.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior Stephanie Shipley of Thiel surpassed 2,000 career digs last week ... Senior DS Kim Budd moved into second-place all-time on the Grove City career dig charts with 1,866 ... Seniors Courtney Holdrieth and Ashlee Miller posted their 1,000th career dig and assist, respectively, for W&J last week ... Devin McGrath had 57 assists and 26 digs last week for 0-2 Saint Vincent ... Junior MB Lindsay Speidel posted 3.11 kps and eight blocks last week for 1-2 Westminster.

#### **Bethany Bison** (21-12, 9-7 PAC)

The Bison closed the regular season with three fiveset battles, dropping contests to Thiel and Westminster before outlasting W&J ... Taylor

Cassidy matched her career-high with 17 kills and Jessica Cole posted 14 kills and 22 digs in the Thiel match ... Bethany's narrow loss to Westminster was highlighted by Carrie Talkington delivering a careerhigh 19 kills and Tiffany Hoffman bringing up 25 digs, which gave her 1.500 in her career ... In the W&J win, which gave the Bison a schoolrecord 9 PAC wins this year, Talkington had 14 kills, Jessica Zavatchen passed out 44 assists and Cole totaled 11 kills and 13 digs ... Bethany goes into the PAC Tournament this week as the #5 seed.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes (26-5)

Here's a news flash, Geneva had another perfect week ... Although it may sound like a broken record, it is really the fact that the 2010 squad has now put GOLDEN TORNADOES together the best season in school history ... With

a 3-0 victory over Saint Vincent Tuesday, the Golden Tornadoes broke the single season record for victories ... At week's end, Geneva had added two more wins to the tally and finished the regular season with a mark of 26-5 ... The previous record of 23 wins was set back in 1986 and stood for 24 years ... Seniors Adriane Blake and Laura Zerbe were honored prior to Thursday's victory over Grove City and each played a significant role in dispatching the Wolverines.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats (21-10, 10-6 PAC)

The Bearcats went 0-2 on the week, but were still able to wrap up fourth place in the PAC, finishing with a 21-10 overall mark, and 10-6 in conference play ... The duo of Taylor Guido and Natalie Hozak were the

team's top producers on the week, as Hozak tallied 18 kills and 44 digs in two matches, including a 13-kill, 26-dig performance in a five set loss at Thiel on Saturday, while Guido had 16 kills and 32 digs on the week, including a 10-kill, 17-dig match at Thiel ... Devin McGrath posted 57 assists and 26 digs on the week, while Kaley Burkardt notched a career-high 15 digs at Thiel.

The Waynesburg women's volleyball team ended its season with 3-0 losses to the top two teams in the PAC, Thiel and Thomas More, over a span of three days.




#### Chatham Cougars (4-27, 0-16 PAC)
