### TOURNAMENT RESULTS

#### Friday, October 31 - First Round Matches

#3 Westminster d. #6 Bethany (30-15, 30-25, 33-31)

Westminster advanced to a semifinal matchup with W&J after dispatching of the sixth-seeded Bison in straight sets, including overcoming a 25-20 second game deficit with a 10-0 run to end the game. Senior OH Diana Barnes (Twinsburg, OH/Twinsburg H.S.) led the way for the Lady Titans with team-high totals of 11 kills, 11 digs and four service aces, while freshman MH Heidi Kracker (Cortland, OH/Lakeview H.S.) added eight kills. For Bethany, sophomore MH Peggy Emmerling (Chester, WV/Oak Glen H.S.) posted a match-high 12 kills and senior OH Shae Baxter (Malvern, OH/Malvern H.S.) added eight, while senior Jennifer Matovich (Clarksville, PA/Jefferson-Morgan H.S.) contributed 12 digs.

#5 Thiel d. #4 Grove City (19-30, 30-27, 28-30, 30-25, 15-12)

The Tomcats pulled the upset over the Lady Wolverines in an opening round match, as Thiel rallied from a 6-0 deficit in the fifth game to advance to face top-seeded Waynesburg in the semifinals. Junior MH Jessica Erickson (Harborcreek, PA/Harbor Creek H.S.) and senior OH Jan Willman (Kittanning, PA/Elderton H.S.) led the victors with 20 kills apiece, while senior Tiffany Snyder (Toronto, OH/Edison H.S.) set up 67 assists. For Grove City, senior OH Lisa Bodi (Springville, NY/Springville Griffith Institute) had match-high totals of 22 kills and 22 digs, while sophomore Carly Denniston (Grove City/Grove City H.S.) posted 45 assists and freshman MH Carlisle Roberts (Union City, PA/Union City H.S.) added eight blocks.

#### Saturday, November 1 - Semifinal Matches

#1 Waynesburg d. #5 Thiel (30-28, 30-20, 30-9)

The top-seeded Yellow Jackets rolled into the championship match by posting 18 team service aces against the fifth-seeded Tomcats in one PAC semifinal match. Sophomore MH Brittany Morrow (Beaver, PA/Beaver H.S.) led the way for Waynesburg with 13 kills, while senior OH Ronnie Jo Meyers (Windber, PA/Windber H.S.) added

eight. Junior S Katie Beall (Fairview, PA/Fairview H.S.) set up 32 assists in the victory. For Thiel, senior OH Jan Willman (Kittanning, PA/Elderton H.S.) led the team in kills with nine, while junior MH Jessica Erickson (Harborcreek, PA/Harbor Creek H.S.) added seven kills and two blocks and freshman S Erin Plaso (Streetsboro, OH/Streetsboro H.S.) recorded 14 digs.

#3 Westminster d. #2 Washington & Jefferson  
(19-30, 30-26, 30-26, 33-31)

Westminster posted its second win in as many days, as the Lady Titans avenged a pair of regular season losses to W&J by upsetting the second-seeded Presidents in the other semifinal match. Sophomore OH Erin Hinks (Warren, OH/Mineral Ridge H.S.) led the Lady Titan offense with 13 kills, while senior OH Diana Barnes (Twinsburg, OH/Twinsburg H.S.) added 10. Sophomore Candice Anderson (New Wilmington/Mercer H.S.) set up 18 assists in the victory. Washington & Jefferson was paced by junior OH Jerica Lamens (Schellsburg, PA/Berlin-Brothersvalley H.S.) with team-high totals of 14 kills and 16 digs. Sophomore MH Becky Fletcher (Indiana, PA/Penns Manor H.S.) added 12 kills, seven digs and three blocks, while freshman S Jamie Gullen (Steubenville, OH/Steubenville H.S.) recorded 50 assists and 12 digs.

#### Saturday, November 1 - PAC Championship Match

#1 Waynesburg d. #3 Westminster (30-26, 30-10, 30-24)

The top-seeded Yellow Jackets posted their third PAC volleyball title in school history and first since 1991 with the sweep of Westminster, which was trying to capture its second consecutive league crown. Waynesburg is now 34-4 overall and is riding a 26-match winning streak, while the Yellow Jackets finished with a perfect 12-0 record against PAC competition in 2003. Sophomore MH Brittany Morrow (Beaver, PA/Beaver H.S.) and senior OH Ronnie Jo Meyers (Windber, PA/Windber H.S.) posted 14 and 13 kills, respectively, for Waynesburg. Junior S Katie Beall (Fairview, PA/Fairview H.S.) added 37 assists, while Kathryn Austen (Jeromesville, OH/Hillsdale H.S.) recorded 11 digs. Senior OH Diana Barnes (Twinsburg, OH/Twinsburg H.S.) posted eight kills and eight digs for Westminster, while senior LIB McKenzie Crowell (Leetonia, OH/Crestview H.S.) added 10 digs in the loss.
