She matched her career-high total with 28 points in the win over the Bison, then added 25 markers in the victory against the Tomcats. Slater also moved into third place on the GCC career scoring charts with 1,343 points and needs just five points to pass Theresa Berg (1989-93) for second place all-time at Grove City.

Also nominated was junior G/F Renee Shepherd of Bethany, senior C Sonjia Hoston of Chatham, junior F Brittany Sedlock of Saint Vincent, sophomore G Chelsea Tolliver of Thomas More, junior F Ashley Kirkpatrick of Wash. & Jeff., sjunior PG Hannah Hunter of Waynesburg, and senior G Kaitlin McCarthy of Westminster.



PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 7 Conference Notes

2011 UNDERWAY: The start of the new year means the race for the PAC regular season title is underway, with national powers Thomas More and Saint Vincent currently unbeaten (5-0) in league play ... The Saints, who are ranked a PAC all-time best #3 in the nation in both polls, went 3-0 vs. PAC foes last week, while the Bearcats also were a perfect 3-0 against PAC foes, including a 40-point win at W&J ... The first TMC/SVC matchup is Wed., Jan. 19 at Thomas More.

NEWS AND NOTES: Junior F Brittany Sedlock averaged a double-double (14.0 ppg and 10.0 rpg) for 3-0 Saint Vincent ... Sophomore G Chelsea Tolliver averaged 14.7 ppg and 3.7 rpg last week for 3-0 Thomas More ... Alison Wells scored a career-high 18 points for Grove City in a PAC win at Bethany ... Val Hamilton scored the final three points and made a gamesaving steal for Geneva in the closing seconds of a 71-70 win over Chatham ... Hannah Hunter averaged 17.7 ppg for 2-1 Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Kelly Muffley's three-pointer with five seconds left lifted Thiel over Bethany, 71-70, on Monday ... Sonjia Hoston posted 16 points and nine rebounds for Chatham in a PAC loss to Geneva ... Westminster senior G Kaitlin McCarthy averaged 17.0 ppg and 6.5 apg for 0-2 Westminster ... Bethany junior G/F Renee Shepherd had a double-double with 10 points and 11 boards in a loss to Grove City ... Ashley Kirkpatrick scored a career-high 19 points for W&J at Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (6-7, 1-4 PAC)

The Bison lost three close games week in their first action of the New Year ... Bethany led Thiel 70-62 with three minutes to play, but the Tomcats scored



the game's final nine points, including a trey with six seconds left to pull out a 72-71 win ... **Kayla Taormina** and **Katelynn Hackathorn** both scored 18 in the setback ... After trailing by 15 in the second half, BC rallied to tie Grove City at 59-59, but the Wolverines scored the final seven points for a 66-59 win ... After Bethany cut a 15-point second half deficit to two, Saint Vincent went on a 21-5 spurt to pull away for a 76-64 triumph over the Bison ... **Renee Shepherd** and **Audra Droginske** both scored 15 in the loss.

Chatham Cougars (5-7, 1-3 PAC)

The Cougars returned to PAC play this week as they hosted Geneva on Saturday ... The GTs led by two at halftime and were able to withstand two rallies by the Cougars to secure the 71-70 win ... These results do not count towards overall PAC standings because of Geneva's NCAA Division III provisional status ... Four Cougars finished in double figures in the loss ... Sonjia Hoston led all scoring with a season-high 16 points and tied a season-high record with nine rebounds ... Senior Kayla Hilko finished with 15 points, while teammates Colleen Kiss and Lizz King added 12 and 11 points, respectively ... This is the first game of the season that Chatham has allowed a team to score more than 70 points.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (7-6)

In women's action, the week began with Geneva still stuck in an offensive rut ... The GTs averaged only 32.5 points in losses to Thomas More and Saint Vincent to open the week ... With their record



falling back to .500 at 6-6, Geneva went back to the road on Saturday and found its offense ... Taking a 16-point second half lead over Chatham, the GTs held on down the stretch for a 71-70 victory to move their record to 7-6 ... Beth DeLuca found her shooting touch with four three-point field goals as Geneva shot nearly 47% from the field in earning the victory ... Geneva takes its 7-6 overall record into a new week that features home games against rivals Grove City and Westminster.

Grove City Wolverines (6-5, 3-2 PAC)

The new year has been good to the Wolverines so far as they earned seven-point wins over Bethany (66-59) and Thiel (68-61) last week ... Thursday at Bethany, GCC



never trailed but need a 7-0 run down the stretch to clinch the win ... Christine Slater matched her career high with 28 points while Alison Wells set a new career high with 18 points ... Jenna Johnston hauled in a career-best 11 rebounds ... Saturday, four Wolverines scored in double figures as Grove City held off visiting Thiel ... Slater fired in 25 points while Leah Gibson added 14 ... Wells and Megan Gebrosky each scored 10 ... Slater moved into third place on Grove City's all-time scoring list ... She now has 1,343 career points.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (12-1, 5-0 PAC)

The Bearcats stretched their winning streak to six, and improved to 5-0 in PAC play, with three wins on the week ... Monday at W&J, SVC defeated the Presidents 72-32, the first Bearcat win over the Presidents since joining the PAC in 2006 ... Maria Baroffio scored a game-high 17 points, while Brittany Sedlock scored 13 with 15 rebounds ... The SVC defense allowed just 12 field goals for the game and forced 24 turnovers ... Thursday vs Geneva, the defense was again the story, with the Bearcats forcing 32 turnovers ... Sedlock and Melissa Mansur each scored 12, while Devin McGrath made eight steals ... Saturday at Bethany, Baroffio led the charge with 22 points, going 4-for-5 from long range.

Thiel Tomcats (2-11, 1-4 PAC)

Thiel picked up its second win of the season but still lost two of three games to drop to 2-11 on the season ... The Tomcats were able to pick up a victory over



Bethany as sophomore G Kelly Muffley sank a three-point basket to give Thiel the 71-70 lead with just five seconds to go ... Junior F Ashley Davis had her most productive game since her return as she had 14 points and 14 rebounds for her first double-double of the season ... Senior F Jasmin Jones also had her best game of the season with a 24-point performance ... Game two of the week saw the Tomcats continue to play well but fall to Waynesburg 77-69 ... Muffley had a teamhigh 17 points... Thiel was also defeated by Grove City 68-61.

Thomas More Saints (13-0, 5-0 PAC)

The Saints moved up to No. 3 in both the <u>D3hoops.com</u> Top-25 and the WBCA's USA Today/ESPN Coaches Poll last week ... The No. 3



ranking matches the program's highest-ever ranking when it was ranked No. 3 during the 2007-2008 undefeated regular-season campaign ... Sophomore G Chelsea Tolliver and senior C Nicole Dickman both averaged in double-digit scoring last week as they averaged 14.7 and 13.7 points per game respectively ... Dickman and sophomore F/C Katie Kees led the team on the boards last week as they each averaged 7.7 rebounds per game ... For the season, the Saints are shooting 42.5 percent from the field on 316-of-744 shooting.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (5-8, 3-2 PAC)

W&J began the week with a 72-32 defeat at the hands of Saint Vincent ... Junior F **Courtney Walsh** posted a double-double, scoring 12 points and hauling in 11 rebounds ... W&J couldn't overcome poor shooting in the second half in nearly pull off an upset at Thomas More

Wednesday, ultimately falling 58-52 to the #3 Saints ... W&J shot 44 percent in the first half to race to a 25-22 halftime lead, but shot just 27 percent in the second half ... Junior PG **Vanessa Rivera** scored a team-high 11 points and recorded five assists ... Two players hit career highs in points in the Presidents' 66-58 victory over Westminster on Saturday ... Rivera tied her career high with 15 points.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (10-3, 4-2 PAC)

The Yellow Jacket women enjoyed a 2-1 week in PAC play after wins over Westminster and Thiel, before falling at home to national power Thomas



More ... During their victory over the Tomcats, the Jackets erased a 12-point second-half deficit to pick up a 77-69 triumph ... Waynesburg also showed impressive resilience against Thomas More, out-scoring the Saints 25-23 in the second half ... As has been the case for most of the season, the Jackets were led by the combination of senior F **Elisha Jones** and junior PG **Hannah Hunter** ... Jones averaged 15.3 points, 6.7 rebounds and 2.3 steals per game, while Hunter led all Waynesburg players in scoring (17.7 ppg) and steals (2.6 spg).

Westminster Titans (3-11, 0-6 PAC)

Westminster has lost six straight PAC games for the first time since the Titans joined the league in 2000 after they lost two home games last week



vs. Waynesburg, 78-75, Tuesday and Washington & Jefferson, 66-58, Saturday ... Senior PG **Kaitlin McCarthy** averaged 17.0 points and 6.5 assists per game, including 16 points and six assists vs. Waynesburg and 18 points and a season-high seven assists vs. W&J ... She moved into third place on Westminster's career assists list with 341, surpassing **Jennifer Petures** (1999-2003) who had 336 for third place ... Still ahead of McCarthy are **Pam Beatty** (1987-91) with 550 and **Brenda Rodgers** (1982-86) with 384.
