PAC TOP 25 DUO: For the first time in league women's basketball history, a pair of PAC teams are ranked in the national Top 25 at the same time ... In the <u>D3Hoops.com</u> poll released on January 11, defending PAC champion Thomas More was ranked 16th in the nation, while current league leader Washington & Jefferson was ranked 25th ... W&J took control of the league standings with a 68-62 win over the Saints (who previously had been ranked as high as fourth in the nation) on January 10.


WHO'S HOT: W&J junior F Maggie Gibson averaged 10.5 points and 16.0 rebounds per game for the 2-0 Presidents last week ... Freshman F Callie White averaged 22.0 points per game for 0-2 Waynesburg, including a careerbest 24 vs. W&J ... Freshman F Towanda-Michelle Warren led 1-1 Thiel by averaging 18.5 ppg last week ... Senior G Gina Brunetti averaged 18.5 ppg for 1-1 Westminster ... Sophomore F Christine Slater averaged 16.5 points and 12.0 rebounds for 1-1 Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Bethany senior G Caelyn DiSanti held the top scorers from Chatham (Kayla Hilko-8) and Westminster (Amy Dolsak-7) well below their season averages in two Bison wins ... Saint Vincent freshman G Emily Fenton scored a career-high 23 points in a 71-67 win over Grove City ... Sophomore Barb Petty scored a season-high 22 points for Chatham in a 60-56 PAC loss to Bethany ... Beth DeLuca scored 14 points for Geneva in a 74-60 road PAC loss at Thiel.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (6-9, 2-4 PAC)

Bethany picked up its first two PAC wins of the year last week by edging Chatham 60-56 and Westminster 67-62 ... Renee Brandenburg had 11 of her 13



Chatham Cougars (7-7, 1-5 PAC)

Chatham sophomore Barb Petty scored a season high 22 points in a 60-56 loss to PAC foe Bethany College ...

Chatham held a three-point halftime lead against the Bison, but found themselves down by 12 points midway through the second half ... The Cougars cut their deficit to just two points with less than a minute remaining, but could not finish the rally ... Chatham traveled to Thomas More and ran into a dominating defensive effort by the Saints ... Thomas More held Chatham to just 14 points in the final 28 minutes of the game and won by a 75-27 score.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (7-7)

After cruising through a 3-0 week two weeks ago, the Golden Tornadoes suffered a pair of losses last week, first dropping a 77-59 decision to 16th- GOLDEN TORNADOES ranked Thomas More and then falling 74-60 at Thiel



Saturday ... Rachel Barry and Michawn Rich each scored 13 points in the loss to Thomas More as the Golden Tornadoes managed just eight first half field goals in falling behind 38-22 after 20 minutes ... Geneva rallied from a 20-point second half deficit at Thiel to pull within three points on two separate ocassions, but were never able to claim the lead ... Beth DeLuca rallied Geneva with 12 of her 14 points coming in the second half.

Grove City Wolverines (6-9, 3-3 PAC)

Grove City is in sole possession of third place in the PAC after holding off Waynesburg Wednesday 61-51 ... Christine Slater paced GCC with a 14-point, 11-rebound



double-double, while Laura Miller added 14 points ... Jayme Caldwell added a career-high 13 points ... Saturday, Grove City dropped a 71-67 decision at Saint Vincent despite having four players score in double figures ... Slater recorded 19 points and 13 rebounds while Megan Gebrosky rifled in 14 points ... Raeann Szelong (13) and Caldwell (12) also scored in doubles ... The Wolverines turned the ball over 30 times ... Grove City had won 12 straight games when scoring at least 61 points prior to Saturday night's setback.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (10-4)

The Lady Bearcats split a pair of games against PAC foes on the week, falling 79-68 at conference-leader W&J before defeating Grove City 71-67 at home Saturday ... In Wednesday's defeat, SVC led 41-36 at the half

before W&J came back for the win ... Maria Baroffio scored a careerhigh 22 points, while Maura Wahl added 13 and Ashley Campbell 11 ... With Saturday's win over Grove City, the Lady Bearcats improved to 6-0 at home on the year ... Freshman Emily Fenton recorded a gamehigh and career-high 23 points, going 5-of-9 from beyond the arc, while Wahl scored 21, her fourth straight double-digit scoring performance .. Brittany Sedlock led the way on the glass, grabbing 10 rebounds.

Thiel Tomcats (7-7, 2-4 PAC)

Thiel women's basketball suffered a heartbreaking overtime loss to the Westminster Titan, 70-76, in New Wilmington last Wednesday ... The Tomcats were



lead by freshman F Towanda-Michelle Warren, whose 16-point second half brought the Tomcats to the brink of victory with less than a minute to go in the game ... Once in overtime, Thiel couldn't maintain momentum, and dropped its first road game since Nov. 21 ... Saturday, the Tomcats ended their four-game home losing streak when they beat the Geneva Golden Tornadoes, 74-60 ... Amber Bodrick and Warren lead Thiel to victory, scoring 21 points apiece.

Thomas More Saints (13-2, 6-1 PAC)

Thomas More, ranked No. 16 last week in the D3hoops.com and WBCA Top-25 polls, swept its two games last week by defeating Geneva, 77-



59, Wednesday and defeating Chatham on Saturday, 75-27... In the win over Geneva, sophomore C Nicole Dickman recorded her third and TMC's fourth double-double of the season as she scored 20 points and pulled down 11 rebounds ... Joining her in double-figures against the GTs was sophomore F Amy Stultz with 12 points, senior G Alex Gee with 11 and senior G Jayme Thiem and senior F Kirsten Humphrey each with 10 points apiece ... In the win against Chatham, Thiem scored a game-high 18 points and Dickman finished with 17 points.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (14-1, 6-0 PAC)

The 25th-ranked W&J women's basketball program extended its current win streak to 11 games last week, defeating Saint Vincent and Waynesburg ... With the victory over Waynesburg Saturday, the Presidents are off to their best start in PAC play since the 2004-05



season when W&J also posted a perfect record through six conference contests ... The Presidents, who have connected on 74-of-201 attempts from beyond the arc, currently sit as the top three-point shooting team in the conference and the 10th best in the nation ... With 171 total points and 176 rebounds, junior F Maggie Gibson is currently the only player in the PAC averaging a double-double.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-10, 2-4 PAC)

The Yellow Jacket women dropped a pair of PAC contests last week ... Following a 61-51 road loss to Grove City, the Jackets gave a solid effort against



nationally-ranked W&J before falling 66-56 ... All in attendance at the games witnessed a pair of outstanding performances by freshman F Callie White ... Against the Wolverines, White poured in a game-best 20 points ... The Jackets also got 13 points out of sophomore F Elisha Jones ... White out-did herself against W&J as she went for a contesthigh and season-best 24 points in the loss to the Presidents, including a whopping 22 points in the second half. Jones also recorded her secondstraight double-digit scoring game with 12.

Westminster Titans (6-8, 3-4 PAC)

Four Titan players averaged double figures in points as Westminster split two PAC home games last week, beating Thiel, 76-70, in overtime and



losing to Bethany, 67-62 ... Senior G Gina Brunetti averaged 18.5 points including a season-high 20 points vs. Thiel and 17 points - on a season-high five 3-pointers - in the loss to Bethany ... Brunetti's 3pointer with 24 seconds left vs. Thiel sent the game to overtime ... Junior G Amy Dolsak posted career-highs in both points and rebounds with 25 points and 18 rebounds in the win over Thiel, while scoring seven points to go with a team-high eight rebounds vs. Bethany ... Sophomore G Kaitlin McCarthy averaged 15.5 points in the two contests.

Bethany last defeated Thomas More in Dec., 2003.

Thomas More Saints vs. Saint Vincent* (1/21) at Bethany* (1/24)

Thomas More enters the week ranked No. 16 nationally by both the Women's Basketball Coaches

Association (WBCA) and the internet web site D3hoops.com ... Thomas More is 12-0 all-time against Saint Vincent and Bethany ... The Saints defeated the Bison earlier this season, 86-59, on December 3, 2008 in Crestview Hills, as the Saints shot 58.5 percent from the field as they made 31-of-53 shots from the floor, while holding the Bison to 34.4 percent shooting from the field (22-of-64).

Washington & Jefferson Presidents at Bethany* (1/21) at Chatham* (1/24)

The Presidents and Bison will meet for the 57th time in history with W&J leading the series by a 37-29 margin ... W&J has played Bethany more times than any other team in history ... The Presidents have defeated BC six

consecutive times, sweeping each of the last three season series ... Washington & Jefferson has won all 11 games throughout history versus Chatham ... W&J earned a 79-40 win in Washington on Dec. 3rd behind Maggie Gibson's 10-point, 10-rebound double-double ... The Presidents limited the Cougars to 27 percent shooting and forced 24 turnovers.
