Bodrick earned her second PAC Player of the Week honor this season after averaging 22.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game in Tomcat wins over PAC foes Grove City (54-44) and Waynesburg (57-56). She posted 23 points and seven boards in the GCC victory, then came a rebound shy of a double-double after recording 21 points and nine caroms against the Yellow Jackets.

Also nominated was sophomore G **Stacy Goode** of Bethany, sophomore F **Christine Slater** of Grove City, sophomore C **Nicole Dickman** of Thomas More, senior F **Emily Hays** of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore F **Elisha Jones** of Waynesburg, and senior G **Gina Brunetti** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 8 Conference Notes

W&J LOSS CAUSES TIE: The first big upset of the 2008-09 PAC women's basketball season has resulted in a tie for the league lead between Washington & Jefferson and Thomas More ... W&J, which opened the week in sole possession of the conference lead, suffered its first PAC loss of the 2008-09 season on Wednesday at Bethany 66-61 ... The Presidents and Saints will meet again on Wednesday, Feb. 11 in Kentucky ... PAC road teams were 5-0 in league action on Saturday.

WHO'S HOT: Thomas More is ranked #14 by D3Hoops.com and #15 by the WBCA/USA Today poll ... W&J is ranked 20th by D3Hoops.com and 24th by the WBCA/USA Today ... Sophomore G **Kelly Goode** scored a team-high 15 points to lead Bethany to its upset win over W&J ... Sophomore F **Christine Slater** averaged a double-double (19.0 ppg, 10.5 rpg) for 1-1 Grove City ... **Brittany Sedlock** posted a 13-point, 13-rebound double-double for Saint Vincent in a 62-60 win at Westminster.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: **Elisha Jones** led Waynesburg to a 2-1 week by averaging 12.0 ppg and 5.3 rpg ... **Michawn Rich** posted 17 points and nine rebounds for Geneva in a 67-65 win over Westminster ... Westminster senior G **Gina Brunetti** posted a team-high 15.5 ppg in a pair of PAC losses ... Chatham sophomore **Kayla Hilko** scored 16 points for the Cougars in a 62-50 PAC loss to league co-leader W&J ... Thiel is 6-1 in road games this season after posting a pair of PAC road wins last week.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (7-10, 3-5 PAC)



Bethany managed a split in its two games with ranked PAC opponents last week, stunning #20 W&J 66-61 before falling 83-64 against #14 Thomas More ... The Bison trailed for only 1:39 of the game against the Presidents and shot a season-best 57 percent (8-of-14) from the arc to snap a 6-game losing streak to W&J ... **Kelly** (15) and **Stacy Goode** (10) combined for 25 points and went 6-of-7 from deep to pace the offense, while **Renee Brandenburg** had 10 points, nine rebounds and three blocks ... BC was within 20-16 against Thomas More in the 1st half, but a 22-7 Saints run closed the half ... Stacy Goode led Bethany with 14 points and **Renee Shepherd** had a career-high 10 points.

Chatham Cougars (8-9, 1-7 PAC)



Chatham earned a non-conference win at Wilson College by a 55-33 score ... Sophomore **Barb Petty** had 10 point in the win ... The Cougars returned to conference play and fell to Waynesburg and Washington and Jefferson at home by scores of 46-36 and 62-50, respectively ... Chatham held a 12-point lead against W&J early in the second half but could not hold on for the win ... Chatham got strong efforts from Petty, who finished with 12 points on 4-of-8 shooting from behind the arc, and sophomore **Kayla Hilko** who finished with 16 points to lead Chatham ... Senior **Allason Holt** added 10 rebounds in the loss.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-8)



Geneva split a pair of games against PAC opponents last week ... After holding on to a two-point victory over Westminster Wednesday, the GTs dropped a 57-43 decision vs. Grove City ... Geneva saw a 20-point second half lead disappear, but was able to hold on against Westminster ... **Michawn Rich** was one of four players in double figures with a team-best 17 points and nine rebounds ... Geneva's offense struggled Saturday with 31 turnovers ... **Rachel Barry** was one of the lone bright spots with a team-best 15 points including a 9-of-10 effort from the foul line ... The Golden Tornadoes managed just six second half field goals, as Grove City outscored Geneva by 17 points.

Grove City Wolverines (7-10, 3-4 PAC)



Grove City completed a season sweep of Geneva Saturday by rallying for a 57-43 win ... The Wolverines trailed 23-20 at the half ... **Megan Gebrosky** fired in 15 points – all in the second half – to pace GCC ... **Christine Slater** recorded a 13-point, 10-rebound double-double while **Krista Beechy** posted 12 points and 11 rebounds ... Grove City shot 13 of 24 (54 percent) from the field in the second half ... GCC forced 31 turnovers ... It is the Wolverines' third straight win over Geneva ... Wednesday, Slater posted 25 points and 11 rebounds but the Wolverines fell to Thiel 54-44 ... Grove City managed just 17 second-half points after leading 27-26 at halftime ... Slater has a PAC-best six double-doubles.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (11-5)



The Bearcats split a pair of games against PAC foes on the week, falling 68-59 at Thomas More Wednesday before rebounding for a tight 62-60 win at Westminster Saturday ... In the game at TMC, SVC led for the first 35 minutes of play before the Saints charged back for the comeback win ... **Emily Fenton** led SVC with 17 points, including a 4-of-7 showing from behind the arc, while **Ashley Campbell** and **Gabbie Kassiss** each scored 10, with Kassiss going 5-of-6 from the floor ... Saturday in New Wilmington, the Bearcats overcame a 30-24 halftime deficit to win 62-60 ... Four players reached double-figures for SVC, including **Maura Wahl** (17 points), **Lauren Reilly** (16), **Brittany Sedlock** (13), and Fenton (11).

Thiel Tomcats (9-7, 4-4 PAC)



Thiel finished the week 2-0 in PAC play, pushing its record on the road to 6-1... The Tomcats left Grove City with a 54-44 victory over the Wolverines ... **Amber Bodrick** finished the day with 23 points on 11-of-20 shooting and seven rebounds, while sophomore F **Kim Stitt** scored eight points and grabbed a team-high nine boards ... Senior G **Catie Sieber** contributed six points and six rebounds to the victory... Thiel continued their good fortune on the road Saturday with a 57-56 squeaker over Waynesburg ... Bodrick finished the day with a game-high 21 points to go along with nine boards and three assists, while Davis finished with ten points and five rebounds ... Sieber contributed nine points.

Thomas More Saints (15-2, 7-1 PAC)



Thomas More, ranked No. 14 last week in the D3hoops.com Top 25 and No. 15 in the WBCA Top 25, swept its two games last week, defeating Saint Vincent, 68-59 on Wednesday and Bethany, 83-64 on Saturday ... In the win over Saint Vincent, the Saints used an 18-0 run midway through the first half to erase a 15-point deficit ... Sophomore C **Nicole Dickman** led all scorers with a career-high 25 points and added a game-high eight rebounds and three blocks ... Senior G **Alex Gee** added 16 markers ... Against Bethany, senior G **Jayme Thiem** led four Saints in double-figures with 17 points, while Dickman and senior F **Kristen Humphrey** each finished with 16 points and junior G **Sarah Yeiser** finished with 13.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-2, 7-1 PAC)



The 20th-ranked Presidents saw their 11-game win streak snapped Wednesday when they dropped a 66-61 thriller against PAC rival Bethany ... The loss was the Presidents' first regular-season PAC setback since February 13, 2008, when the Red & Black dropped a 59-47 contest against Thomas More ... W&J opened up the second-half of conference play with a 62-50 victory over Chatham Saturday ... For the ninth time this season, senior F **Emily Hays** led the Presidents in scoring, firing in 20 points in the 12-point victory against the Cougars ... The Presidents continued their recent struggles from beyond the arc against Chatham, hitting just 24 percent (5-of-21) from long distance.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-11, 3-5 PAC)



The Yellow Jackets came a buzzer-beating two-pointer away from a perfect 3-0 stretch this past week ... The week got off to an excellent start as Waynesburg rolled over Penn State-Greater Allegheny 80-56 on Monday ... Freshman **Erika Illig** came off the bench to tally a team-best 18 points ... Four different Jackets reached double digits in the victory ... Waynesburg relied on their defense to grind out a 46-36 PAC win over Chatham ... Freshman **Callie White** was the top performer in a sloppy contest, as she notched her first collegiate double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds ... Sophomore F **Elisha Jones** led the Jackets with 17 points in a last-second 57-56 home loss to Thiel.

Westminster Titans (6-10, 3-4 PAC)



Westminster went 0-2 last week, losing both games by two points each ... The Titans came up short, 67-65, against Geneva Wednesday and dropped a 62-60 home decision to Saint Vincent Saturday ... Sisters **Amy Dolsak** and **Emily Dolsak** nearly accounted for half of Westminster's points against Geneva ... Older sister Amy led the Titans with 17 points and 10 rebounds, while younger sibling Emily scored a career-high 16 points for the third time this season ... Saturday, senior G **Gina Brunetti** led the Titans with 15 points ... Sophomore G **Kaitlin McCarthy** also scored in double figures with 12 points to go with a team-high four assists.
