PAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week

SARA SNYDER Thiel College

6-0 Senior Forward
Toronto, Ohio/Edison South H.S.

Snyder averaged 18.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game last week, leading the Tomcats to a 2-0 mark with an upset win at first place Bethany (73-69) followed by a home win against Waynesburg (72-50). She scored a team-high 18 points in the four-point win over the Bison, then added a game-high 19 points in the victory over the Yellow Jackets. Snyder currently leads the Tomcats in scoring (14.0 ppg) and is second in rebounding (6.8 rpg).

Also nominated was sophomore forward **Katie Hardie** of Bethany, senior guard **Stephanie Murphy** of Grove City, sophomore guard **Shawndra McDonald** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior guard **Trisha Pollock** of Waynesburg.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

After starting the week with a disappointing loss to Thiel, the Bison clinched the top seed and hosting rights for the PAC Tournament with a narrow win vs. Grove City ... Bethany lost to Thiel despite shooting better (45 percent to 38 percent) and outrebounding the Cats (43-38) ... The Bison hopes were hurt by 26 turnovers ... Katie Hardie had 26 points and 17 rebounds in the loss ... In the GCC win, Bethany burst out to a 28-8 lead but held off a late GCC second half rally for the win ... Guard Kiki Cohen scored 23 points on 8-12 shooting, including 4-5 from the arc ... Cohen now has 55 triples on the season, breaking her own single-season three-point record that she set last season.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J enters the PAC Tournament as the No. 3 seed after tying Grove City for second place in the conference during the regular season with a 5-3 record ... The Wolverines were awarded the No. 2 seed due to their 1-1 record vs. top-seeded Bethany, while the Presidents lost both matchups with the Bison ... W&J finished the week 1-1 after defeating Waynesburg and falling to Westminster ... Shawndra McDonald scored 21 points and added seven assists, six steals and five rebounds in the win over the Yellow Jackets ... Lauren Hull and Amy Strosnider also added 12 markers ... Hull paced four W&J scorers in double figures on Saturday with 19 points ... McDonald scored 16 points, while Strosnider added 11 points and grabbed a game-high 16 rebounds.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

Grove City settled for the #2 seed at the 2002 PAC Championship Tournament after losing to top seed Bethany on Saturday. 71-65 ... The Lady Wolverines rallied from a 26-6 deficit to cut it to one, 59-58 with 4:28 left, but couldn't overtake the Bison who secured the right to host this year's tournament ... Senior Stephanie Murphy and sophomore Leigh LeGare scored 14 and 13 points, respectively, in the loss ... Grove City was coming off a thrilling double-OT victory over Westminster in which junior Cara Denniston nailed a three-pointer with 10 seconds left in regulation to complete a GCC rally from 11 points down with five minutes left ... Murphy recorded a team-high 18 points, eight rebounds, six assists and six steals.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Thiel Tomcats defeated the Jackets 72-50 Saturday night in the last regular-season conference game ... Senior **Trisha Pollock** led the Jackets with 12 points in the game.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished last week 2-0 and closed out the PAC regular season with one of their biggest wins of the season, defeating Bethany 73-69 at Hummel Fieldhouse ... The Tomcats avenged a 72-55 loss to the Bison at Rissell-Beeghly on Jan. 26th ... Thiel finished with four players in double digits, led by senior Sara Snyder's 18 points and seven rebounds...Sophomore guards Amanda Swanson and Mayumi Sasaki each posted 13 points ... Thiel earned a 22-point win over Waynesburg, defeating the Yellow Jackets 72-50 ... The Tomcats were paced by Snyder's game-high 19 points and four rebounds ... Swanson chipped in with 11 points, 10 rebounds, and five assists.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster went 1-2 last week ... The Lady Titans had their seven-game win streak snapped vs. Mount Union (64-55) on Monday and also fell at Grove City (77-73 in double overtime) on Wednesday, before posting an 80-65 win at Washington & Jefferson on Saturday ... The W&J win clinched the second straight winning season for the Lady Titans ... Westminster finished play against PAC teams with an 8-2 record, bringing the Lady Titans' two-year mark against the PAC to 18-2 ... Senior guard Robin Thayer scored 46 points in the three games last week, bringing her school record career scoring total to 1,264 points.
