Sedlock earned her second PAC Player of the Week honor of the season after averaging 17.0 points and 13.0 rebounds per contest for the 2-0 Bearcats last week, as Saint Vincent recorded PAC wins over Westminster (72-62) and Chatham (62-37). Sedlock posted her fourth and fifth double-doubles of the season as she recorded 20 points (including 9-of-11 accuracy from the foul line) and 10 boards in the road win over the Titans, then posted 14 points and a season-best 16 caroms against the Cougars.

Also nominated was senior C **Katelynn Hackathorn** of Bethany, senior G **Lizz King** of Chatham, junior G **Kelly Muffley** of Thiel, sophomore F/C **Katie Kees** of Thomas More, senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of Washington & Jefferson, junior G **Brittany Spencer** of Waynesburg, and senior F **Emily Dolsak** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 3 Conference Notes

OFF AND RUNNING: The PAC women's basketball schedule for 2011-12 got underway last Wednesday and Saturday with a full schedule of PAC contests on each date ... Five-time defending PAC champion Thomas More is one of four conference squads to start the season 2-0 in league play, as the Saints are joined by fellow national power Saint Vincent, Bethany and Waynesburg ... TMC travels to Bethany Saturday afternoon for a key early season matchup at 2 p.m.

NEWS AND NOTES: Junior G **Brittany Spencer** averaged 15.5 points and 8.0 boards last week for 2-0 Waynesburg, including a 22-point, 12-board double-double vs. Westminster ... Sophomore F/C **Katie Kees** averaged 12.0 points and 9.5 rebounds for 2-0 Thomas More ... Junior G **Kelly Muffley** averaged 17.0 ppg for 1-1 Thiel, including 22 points in the Tomcat win over W&J ... Bethany is 2-0 in the PAC for the first time since 2006-07 after **Taylor Verrico** scored a career-high 13 points vs. Geneva.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior **Emily Fenton** averaged 11.0 ppg for 2-0 Saint Vincent ... Senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** averaged 19.5 ppg for 1-1 W&J ... Junior G **Chelsea D'Urso** averaged 15.5 ppg last week for 0-2 Geneva, including 19 in a loss to Thomas More ... Senior G **Lizz King** averaged 12.0 ppg on eight three-pointers for 0-2 Chatham ... Senior F **Emily Dolsak** averaged 11.5 points and 9.5 rebounds last week for 0-2 Westminster ... **Leah Gibson** paced Grove City with 18 points vs. Bethany.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (3-3, 2-0 PAC)



Bethany enjoyed a big week, taking three victories by an average of 20.7 points ... Twelve different players scored, led by **Audra Droginske** and **Kayla Taormina** with 10 apiece, in a 74-50 victory over Franciscan ... Senior **Katelynn Hackathorn** (18 points, 11 rebounds) and **Anne Wilson** (14 points, six assists, five rebounds) led the way for a 79-67 win at Grove City ... The Bison bench sparked the way for a 61-35 triumph over Geneva Saturday, as Bison reserves held a 31-2 scoring advantage over the GTs ... Fittingly, the top two scorers came off the bench, as **Taylor Verrico** went for a career-high 13 and **Kelly Zogran** hit for 10, as Bethany started out 2-0 in PAC for the first time since 2006-07.

Chatham Cougars (2-4, 0-2 PAC)



In the loss against W&J, **Andie Gaetano** led the Cougars with 15 points and six rebounds ... She was joined by **Lizz King** who added 12 points ... King recorded the game high in 3-point goals with 4-for-7 ... **Marguerite Sargent** led the team in assists with five ... The Cougars shot 33.3% from the floor, 41.7% from behind the arc, and 80.0% from the free throw line. In the loss to St. Vincent, the Cougars cut a 14-point Saint Vincent lead to three with a 3-point goal from Lizz King with 2:08 to play in the first half ... Saint Vincent then went on an 8-0 run to keep the lead into halftime, 32-21 ... For the Cougars, King led the team with 12 points, all were off of 3-point goals ... **Becky Rowe** recorded nine points with three 3-point goals.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (1-5, 0-2 PAC)



It was a rough week on the basketball court for the Golden Tornadoes ... The GT women dropped PAC games to Thomas More and Bethany last week to open the PAC schedule at 0-2 ... Geneva has started the new season with an overall record of 1-5, including five straight losses after winning the season opener ... Junior G **Chelsea D'Urso** was solid with 19 points against Thomas More and 12 at Bethany ... D'Urso leads Geneva with an 11-point per game average ... **Beth DeLuca** is averaging 10 points per game, while also tying for the team lead with 6.2 rebounds per game ... Geneva will get two more cracks this week at picking up its first PAC victory.

Grove City Wolverines (1-5, 0-2 PAC)



The Grove City women's basketball team opened PAC play with a pair of setbacks last week ... Wednesday night, the Wolverines scored a season-high 67 points in a 79-67 setback against Bethany ... **Leah Gibson** paced Grove City with 18 points and **Megan Gebrosky** added 13 ... The road team has won each of the last four meetings between the squads ... Saturday, GCC fell on the road at Thomas More ... The Saints held Grove City to 23 percent (12 of 52) shooting from the field ... Gebrosky and Sadie Malone each scored eight points for the Wolverines ... Grove City visits Saint Vincent Wednesday night before hosting Geneva Saturday in the 2011 calendar year home finale.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-1, 2-0 PAC)



SVC began PAC play 2-0 after earning a pair of league wins on the road ... First, SVC captured a 72-62 win over Westminster as defending PAC Player of the Year **Brittany Sedlock** led all scorers with 20 points, she added 10 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season ... Freshman **Elle Collins** registered 11 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals and senior **Emily Fenton** added 10 points ... SVC forced the Titans into 27 turnovers and held the hosts to 36.7 percent from the field and 15.4 percent from three-point range ... At Chatham Saturday, Sedlock again led the charge with 14 points and 16 rebounds while Fenton added 12 points ... SVC forced the Cougars into 32 turnovers.

Thiel Tomcats (1-6, 1-1 PAC)



The Tomcats split a pair of contests to open PAC play ... In the first game of the week, Thiel fell to Waynesburg 61-49 ... A **Rianne Thornton** layup five minutes into the second half gave Thiel a 32-31 lead, however, the Yellow Jackets closed the game with a 29-18 advantage to take the game 61-49 ... Junior G **Kelly Muffley** led the way for Thiel in the contest with 12 points and senior F **Ashley Davis** added 10 of her own ... In the second contest of the week, the Tomcats won their first home game of the season as they defeated the Presidents of W&J 76-66 ... Muffley once again led four Tomcats in double-figures with 22 points, including shooting 14-of-15 from the free throw line.

Thomas More Saints (4-1, 2-0 PAC)



Thomas More, which is ranked No. 17 in the WBCA Top-25, opened the PAC portion of its schedule last week by defeated Geneva, 82-44, and Grove City, 71-29 ... Junior F/C **Katie Kees** led the team in scoring and rebounding last week as she averaged 12.0 points per game and 9.5 rebounds per game ... She scored a career-high 14 points against Geneva and followed that up with her first career double-double (10 points and 11 rebounds) against Grove City ... Sophomore F **Moriah Corey** scored a career-high 17 points and freshman F **Jenny Burgoyne** scored a career-high 13 points against Geneva, while freshman F **Kelli Dixon** scored a career-high 12 points against Grove City.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (3-3, 1-1 PAC)



W&J split a pair of PAC games last week, defeating Chatham Wednesday and falling at Thiel Saturday ... W&J is now 18-0 all-time against the Cougars after its 87-49 victory ... The Presidents scored 38 points off of 35 Chatham turnovers ... All 12 players to see game action recorded at least one steal led by freshman **Alexa Del Greco**, who recorded six swipes ... Freshman **Valerie Dunlap** tallied 12 rebounds, six blocks and six points in just 18 minutes off the bench ... Senior **Ashley Kirkpatrick** scored a career-high 25 points against on 9-of-20 shooting at Thiel ... The Presidents hit 87 percent (20-of-23) of their free throws but shot just 34 percent (22-of-51) from the field.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-2, 2-0 PAC)



The Yellow Jackets opened up PAC play with a pair of conference victories over Thiel and Westminster ... Waynesburg opened up the week on Wednesday with a 61-49 triumph over Thiel and followed that up by holding off a furious comeback during a 60-56 victory over the Titans ... The Jackets were led by junior G **Brittany Spencer**, who averaged a team-high 15.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game, including a 22-point, 12-rebound and six-steal showing against the Tomcats ... Junior G **Jessi Drayer** led Waynesburg against Westminster with a game-high 21 points and averaged 12.0 points per contest over the two wins.

Westminster Titans (0-6, 0-2 PAC)



Westminster fell to 0-6 on the season with a pair of PAC losses, a 72-62 loss at home to Saint Vincent Wednesday and a 60-56 setback at Waynesburg Saturday ... Westminster held second-half leads in both games including a two-point lead at Waynesburg after trailing by 16 points in the second half ... Senior F **Emily Dolsak** averaged 11.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game including 12 points and eight boards vs. Waynesburg ... Three different Titans posted double-doubles vs. Saint Vincent led by sophomore G **Courtney Zitt** posting her first career double-double as she led Westminster with 14 points to go with a career-high 11 rebounds.
