Cohen scored a career-high 20 points as the Bison defeated Muskingum 65-62 in their only game of the week. In the win, Cohen shot 7-of-12 from the floor, including 6-of-9 from behind the three-point arc (just one shy of the College record for three-pointers in a game). She added five rebounds and three assists vs. the Lady Muskies.

Also nominated was freshman center **Kristen Benjamin** of Thiel and senior guard **Trisha Pollock** of Waynesburg.
