# **CHRIS VICENTE**

Waynesburg College

Junior - 141 pounds Philadelphia, Pa./Frankford H.S.

Vicente became the first Waynesburg wrestler to capture a tournament championship this year, as he captured the 141-pound crown at the Heidelberg College Wrestling Invitational. Vicente won a 6-4 decision over Sayre Wuhr of Baldwin-Wallace to win the bracket. He went 4-0 in the tournament win wins over Joe Wise of Muskingum in the second round and Kevin and Kyle Hollar of Manchester in the first and third rounds, respectively.

Also nominated was freshman 141-pounder **Matt Kirsopp** of Thiel, and junior 157-pounder **Chris Day** of Washington & Jefferson.

# PAC WRESTLING NOTES

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel College wrestling squad recently returned to Greenville following a busy weekend in Fort Lauderdale, Fla ... The Tomcats competed in the Citrus Open, an 18-team event, as well as the Citrus Duals, where they wrestled in four dual meets ... Freshman Matt Kirsopp was the top Thiel performer at the Open, finishing in third place ... Kirsopp entered his bracket (141) as the seventh seed and went 4-1 on the day ... Fellow classmate Jonas Hatajik finished in fourth place, but was not designated as the Tomcats point scorer in his weight class (149), therefore didn't contribute points to the overall team score ... Hatajik finished 3-2 at the Classic ... The Tomcats finished 1-3 at the Citrus Duals, falling to Augustana College (33-12), Central College (36-6) and Concordia University (33-12) before earning a 28-18 victory over Wilmington College ... Freshman Mike Young went 4-0 at 285 and senior Steve Dedrick went 3-1 at 149.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J wrestling placed eighth of 14 teams at the 20th Annual Heidelberg College Wrestling Invitational on Saturday afternoon in Tiffin, Ohio ... The Presidents finished with 38.5 points and earned five placewinners ... Baldwin-Wallace claimed the team title with 130.5 points, while Heidelberg (111), Mount Union (107), Muskingum (62.5) and Ashland (49.5) rounded out the top five in the standings ... Junior Chris Day and sophomore Matt Smith both earned runner-up finishes for W&J in their respective weight divisions ... Day, a 157-pounder, picked up a quarterfinal win over Chris Deutcher of Manchester and a semifinal triumph over Richie Minner of Muskingum to move into the championship match, before dropping a 7-1 bout to Mount Union's Drew **Zollars** ... Smith won three matches before losing a tough 10-8 decision to Muskingum's Ben Gray in the finals at 174 pounds ... Senior 133-pounder Kevin **DeJulius** placed third after shutting out Jeff Varney of Baldwin-Wallace in the championship match, 5-0 ... Junior 141pounder Byron Johnson placed fourth, while freshman heavyweight Ryan Wiles, who was competing in his first tournament of the season, posted a sixth-place finish ... Johnson was edged by Muskingum's Erich Holmes, 5-3, in the consolation final ... Wiles was defeated by Manchester's James Samules in the fifth-place match, 9-2 ... W&J opens its 2002-2003 home schedule on Wednesday as it hosts Pensacola Christian at the Henry Memorial Center at 7 p.m.

# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg crowned its first tournament champion of the season Saturday, as junior Chris Vicente captured the 141pound title at the Heidelberg College Wrestling Invitational ... Vicente won a 6-4 decision over Baldwin-Wallace's Sayre Wuhr to win the bracket ... The win helped the Yellow Jackets take home a sixth-place finish with 49 points ... Ten schools competed in the invitational won by Baldwin-Wallace (130.5) followed by Heidelberg (111), Mount Union (107), Muskingum (62.5) and Ashland (49.5) ... Trailing Waynesburg were Manchester (48), Washington & Jefferson (38.5), Ohio Northern (23.5) and West Liberty State (17) ... John Maybury placed in his weight class, as he advanced to the fifthplace bout at 165 before losing to Baldwin-Wallace's Roger Roman on a 10-0 decision ... Waynesburg returns to action Tuesday at it travels to Mt Union ... The Jackets (1-2) open at home on Thursday with Pensacola Christian.
