Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



After almost a month layoff, Waynesburg in seven dual matches in the first part of 2006 ... The Yellow Jackets opened the year at the John Reese Duals, where they lost all four matches with the closest match being a 29-15 loss

to Trinity (Conn.) in the final match of the event ... Senior captain **Ken Laird** claimed four wins, including three via decision at 149-lbs. ... He moved up to the 165-lbs. weight class against Trinity, he pinned his opponent at the 5:50 mark ... Sophomore **Tyler Allen** recorded a 3-1 record at the six-team meet, including a pinfall in his bout against host Wilkes ... On Saturday, Waynesburg took part in a quadrangular meet hosted by Washington & Lee (Va.) ... Allen was the lone Yellow Jacket wrestler to post multiple wins, registering a pair of pinfalls ... Laird also claimed a win at the W&L meet and now boasts 98 career victories.
