In its first action of 2011, Thiel had little trouble defeating Case Western Reserve 41-9 in a dual meet in Greenville Saturday ... Waynesburg was off, as its only scheduled match vs. Penn State-New Kensington was cancelled.

AROUND THE PAC: Thiel freshman Billy Roosa posted his first career victory for the Tomcats by recording a major decision at 184 vs. Case Western Reserve ... Four W&J wrestlers went 3-0 Saturday, including junior Chris Leva (141), sophomore Tyler Berger (157), and frosh David Dibenedetto (165) ... Waynesburg has a busy week with duals at Ohio Valley and at home vs. Mercyhurst-Northeast before hosting its invitational Saturday.

Thiel won all but two matches on its way to



Following a Spartan pin at 149, Thiel increased its lead with wins in the next five matches ... Alec Miller (157) and Patrick Morris (174) tallied pins and Kraig Smith (197) received a forfeit ... Matt Lowry had a nice 4-0 win at 165 that was more dominant than the final score indicated ... Thiel will be off until Saturday when it travels to the Budd Whitehill Duals at Lycoming College.

Junior 141-pounder Chris Leva, sophomores 157-pounder Tyler Berger and 197-pounder Robbie Mies and freshman 165-pounder David Dibenedetto all recorded three victories ... Freshman 149-pounder Josh Etzel won a pair of matches in his season debut ... W&J topped Muskingum by 10 points despite forfeiting three weight classes ... Leva opened with a 10-3 victory over Gettysburg's Dan Traficanti and then topped W&L's Sam Campbell by a 10-4 margin ... Leva ended the day by pinning Luke Caracofe of Muskingum in 4:11 ... Berger pulled out 2-1 victories against Gettysburg's Joe Fiore and W&L's Keith Jaworski and then defeated Muskingum's Tommy Patterson 14-3 ... Dibenedetto now has 19 wins this season.
