### GARRETT JOHNSTON Waynesburg Sophomore 149 pounds Sycamore Pa. West Greene H.S.

The Tomcats' first points of the night on consecutive major decisions by Tommy Kozak and Corey Brown. Kozak took the 133lbs match, 8-0, to improve to 18-6 on the year while Brown won at 141lbs, 16-7... At 165lbs, Alec Miller won a thrilling double-OT decision (2-1) over Brandon Roshon... Brian Greenlee and Patrick Morris earned a pair of decisions at 147 and 184, respectively... Greenlee registered a, 3-0, win in his bout, while Morris improved to 7-6 on the year with his, 2-1, win... On Saturday, Thiel took part in 24th Summa Memorial Tournament, earning fifth place out of 14 teams... The Tomcats host the 2010 PAC Wrestling Championships on Friday.

Mies pin turned around a dual meet for the second Friday in a row as he turned a 17-12 W&J deficit into an 18-17 lead heading into the final match ... Sophomore heavyweight Taylor Potts then delivered a 5-2 victory to seal the win ... Mies has a 14-5 record with nine falls ... Sophomore 157-pounder **Dominick Demor** stretched his win streak to 15 matches and his overall record to 25-6 after defeating Greg Hogan 9-3 ... Freshman 149-pounder Tyler Berger earned a 4-0 triumph to record his 22<sup>nd</sup> victory of the season.

bounded nicely from a blowout loss at Division II power Gannon by placing second at the John Summa Tournament at Baldwin-Wallace College...Freshman Alex Crown (125) not only won his weight class, but was also named the Most Valuable Wrestler of the tournament after beating SUNY Brockport's Tyler Marlow, who was ranked seventh nationally coming into the event, in the finals...Jesse Byerly (141) and Garrett Johnston (149) also took home individual titles...Johnston pinned both of his opponents on his way to the crown...He also scored the Jackets' only win at Gannon when he upset Kevin McElhaney, a 2009 Division II All-American, who was ranked 10<sup>th</sup> in the country, by 8-1 decision... Corbin Semple (184), Jared Roberts (165), Melvin Warrick (285), Josh Klimko (125) and Alex Evanoff (157) added top-three finishes for Waynesburg.
