PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER CAPSULES

Bethany Bison

First-year coach Barry Christmas will guide the Bison women into their first action of the '07 season this weekend at the Defiance Tournament ...

BC will play Medaille, who went 10-8-1 last season, in Saturday's opener and then battle Defiance, who recorded a 5-13-1 mark in 2006, Sunday ... Bethany registered a 4-12-1 record last year, but returns nine letterwinners, while also welcoming in a freshmen class of 11 players ... Junior MF Ruthie Pettle is the top returning offensive player ... At keeper, Bethany welcomes back senior Jess Alloggia, who started two years before missing last year to study abroad, and junior Courtney Teets, who went 4-5-1 last season.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Linda Sumner was named Geneva's new head coach just two weeks ago ... Geneva's second all-time leading goal scorer takes over a Geneva

program that has gone 6-12-0 in each of the last two years ... The Golden Tornadoes have seven returning starters this season.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats have a strong group of returnees this year, led by All-American Erin Mannella ... Mannella anchored the midfield for Saint Vincent in 2004 and 2005, and was named an NAIA All-

American following the 2005 season - just the second player in program history to earn the honor ... She transferred to Seton Hill University for the 2006 season, but returns to Saint Vincent for her senior year in '07 ... Much of last year's starting lineup remains intact this year as well, including leading scorers Kylie Simonini, Alex Shasko and Shelly Teems ... They will be joined by Adrianne Groth, the team's third leading scorer in 2005.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More opens the 2007 season this weekend as the Saints host Asbury on Saturday at Xavier University beginning at 6 p.m.



Chatham Cougars

The Chatham Cougars of head coach Jamie Retersdorf begin their first season as a member of the PAC on Sunday, when they host Hilbert College

at 2 p.m.



Grove City Wolverines

With 19 letterwinners back, Grove City features one of its most experienced squads ever ... Yet, the Wolverines have just three seniors on the roster ... GCC returns seven of its top eight scorers

from 2006, including junior Stephanie Wild, who recorded nine goals last year ... Sophomore Michelle Peck added seven goals and a team-leading five assists ... Grove City also returns All-PAC and all-region GK Diana Pragel ... GCC opens the season with three straight home matches ... This weekend, Grove City hosts Adrian Friday and Aurora on Saturday ... Eight of Grove City's first 11 matches are at College Field.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat women's soccer team and first-year head coach Jeurell Smith begin their 2007 campaign Saturday as they will travel to Mt. Aloysius ... Seven starters return for the Tomcats from 2006.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson opens its 2007 season on Friday under the lights at Alexandre Stadium versus Pitt-Greensburg at 7 p.m. ... The Presidents will be led by a new head coach, Pete Curtis, the former head men's soccer coach at Cleveland State ... W&J

returns 17 letterwinners, including senior MF Liz Monzi ... Junior F Madison Manius led the squad in scoring a year ago with five goals and three assists ... The Bobcats posted a 4-10-3 overall record last year, but return leading scorer Amanda Kotvas (7 goals, 1 assist).



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets of head coach Jim Rue open the 2007 season with a pair of weekend contests at Point Park ... Waynesburg opens the season by

battling Lake Erie Friday at 4 p.m., followed by a matchup with the host Pioneers on Saturday at 4 p.m.



Westminster Titans

Westminster begins the 2007 riding a six-match unbeaten streak dating back to last season ... The Titans won their fourth PAC championship in five years last year and advanced to the semifinals of the ECAC Division III South Championships before being eliminated on penalty kicks after playing Gettysburg to a tie ... The Titans host two matches this weekend, beginning with Aurora on Friday at 6 p.m. and Adrian on Saturday at 5

p.m. ... The Titans return nine starters from last year's PAC championship team that compiled a record of 14-5-3 ... Among them are two-time PAC Player of the Year Mallory Bugel.
