Bethany's 2006 season began on a down note, as Geneva claimed a 4-0 win over the Bison last Friday ... BC was outshot 26-7 in the contest, although the Bison did put five shots on net ... Sophomore **Ruthie Pettle** had a team-high three shots, while sophomore **Rachel Katsur** played a strong game in the midfield ... Freshman **Rachel McConnell** started her first collegiate game and made nine saves in the setback.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City is 2-0 for the first time in four years after earning a pair of shutout victories over the weekend ... Grove City kicked off 2006 with a 3-0 win over 2005 ECAC qualifier Medaille ... Sophomore **Laura Shipley** scored the game-winner in the 13th minute while freshmen **Michelle Peck** and **Lauren Woodring** both scored goals in the second half ... Sophomore **Rebecca Hurley** recorded her first career assist in the victory while GKs **Diana Prigel** and **Bethany Preston** combined on the shutout ... It is Grove City's first shutout in a season opener since 1997 ... Saturday, sophomore **Stephanie Wild** scored the lone goal in a 1-0 victory over 2005 NCAA qualifier Maryville (Tenn.) ... Prigel stopped eight shots ... The Wolverines were out-shot 18-5 but held on for the win.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel women's soccer finished with a 1-1 record during the first weekend of 2006 ... after suffering a 3-0 loss at Hilbert Friday, the Tomcats bounced back with a 2-0 shutout victory over visiting Mount Aloysius Sunday at Alumni Stadium ... Freshman GK **Cyndi Metzler** posted 12 saves for the Tomcats against Hilbert, her first collegiate contest ... Freshman F **Lafaye Moore** tallied a goal and an assist in the shut-out win over Mount Aloysius ... Metzler had four saves in the win for her first collegiate shutout ... Moore scored in the 41st minute on a long run off of a feed by sophomore MF **Jaime Dawson** ... Freshman F **Sarah Thompson** added a goal in the 81st minute off a Moore assist ... The Tomcats had an 18-4 advantage in shots.



Thomas More Saints

Freshmen **Kristin DePaoli** and **Brittany Jones** supplied the Saints with four of the team's five goals with two each ... DePaoli scored Thomas More's first two goals of the season, one off an assist from Jones and another from senior **Cathy Santillo** ... Sophomore **Katie Hughes** added TMC's only other goal.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J posted three different goal scorers in their win over Pitt-Greensburg ... Freshmen **Spencer Ahrenholtz** and junior **Marie Majkut** propelled the Presidents to an early 2-0 first half lead ... It was Ahrenholtz's first goal of her college career ... Following the sole UP-G score, freshmen **Lauren Smith** knocked home her first collegiate goal to give the Presidents a 3-1 lead, and the victory ... Sophomore GK **Jackie Foltz** finished with one save ... W&J held a 23-2 shot advantage ... Junior **Liz Monzi** tallied the eventual game-winning goal in the 74th minute to capture the victory over York 1-0 and the York Tournament Championship ... Foltz had six saves in the shutout ... Senior **Katie Orient**, Majkut, Monzi, and Foltz were all named All-Tournament.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College women's soccer team dropped its season-opening contest, 1-0, against Lake Erie on Friday evening at John F. Wiley Stadium on its new FieldTurf surface ... The Yellow Jacket soccer programs will play a total of four (two men, two women) contests this season at Wiley Stadium, which also will play host to six football games this fall ... The Yellow Jackets scored first when **Joanna Butterworth** netted her first collegiate goal, unassisted, in the first period ... Lake Erie found the net the twice in the first half ... Senior **Erin Mali** paced the offensive attack with three shots, while four other Waynesburg players took multiple shots ... WC junior GK **Amy Mills** recorded 10 saves on 15 shots in net.



Westminster Titans

Westminster won the Westminster/Grove City tournament by shutting out Maryville (Tenn.), 3-0, Friday and blanking Medaille, 5-0, Saturday ... Junior D **Brittany McKee** was named tournament defensive MVP, while classmate F **Sarah Calderone** was named offensive MVP ... Calderone had six points against Medaille as she scored two goals on two shots while also adding a pair of assists ... All-tournament selections **Mallory Bugel** (5) and **Abby Montgomery** (2) combined for seven points during the weekend, including Bugel's one-goal, two-assist game against Medaille and Montgomery netting a goal in the win over Maryville ... Freshman GK **Lindsey Mellott**, the Titans' only non-returning starter in 2006, was perfect in net in her collegiate debut with seven saves in 164 minutes.
