Bethany opened the 2004 PAC season on Saturday at home against Waynesburg and lost by a score of 2-0 ... It was Bethany's only game of the week, as its contest at Carlow was canceled due to poor field conditions. ... The team will play three games this week, two of them at home, including a homecoming weekend game on Saturday against Washington and Jefferson at 11 a.m.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Junior midfielder Toni Lynn Simonini scored a hat trick to lead Washington & Jefferson to a 5-1 victory over Oberlin on Tuesday ... Simonini scored a pair of goals in the first half and junior forward Jen Pergola added a goal as the Presidents staked claim to a 3-1 halftime advantage ... The duo each tallied one score in the second half as W&J cruised to the victory ... Both players added one assist ... Senior GK Gretchen Weber made two saves in 68 minutes to earn the win ... Marietta scored all four of its goals in the first half in defeating W&J in Ohio on Saturday ... Weber took the loss after making six saves in 71 minutes of action ... The Pioneers held a 13-8 shot advantage and attempted 11 corner kicks.

## **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City went 1-1 in non-conference action last week, including a shutout win at Mount Union last Wednesday night ... Junior Stacey Brubaker scored twice in the final eight minutes to give Grove City the victory ... Freshman Bethany Peck and sophomore Maia Siber each had assists ... Goalkeeper Kori Koper picked up her third shutout, stopping six shots ... Ten Grove City players have started all 10 matches so far this year while three others have played in all 10 matches in 2004 ... The Wolverines open conference play at Washington and Jefferson Tuesday night ... Grove City is 15-0-1 in its last 16 regular season PAC matches.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

It was a week of shutouts for Waynesburg ... The Yellow Jackets were shut out Wednesday by Pitt-Greensburg, 2-0, before posting a 2-0 shutout Saturday against Bethany ... The Bobcats limited Waynesburg to two shot attempts... Sophomore GK Emily Byers posted a career-high 25 saves, three shy of her season total prior to the game. ... Byers continued her strong play in goal Saturday against the Bison, posting her second shutout of the season with three saves ... Jackie Sassaman and Kate Zimmerman triggered the Waynesburg scoring in the victory, as both scored goals, while assisting on each other's score ... Zimmerman is now tied for second on the team with four goals, while Sassaman leads with six goals.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-1 last week, earning a 1-0 shutout victory over Lake Erie Tuesday before falling at Baldwin-Wallace 3-0 Thursday ... Senior F Katie Mound tallied the only goal of the game Tuesday. scoring in the 59th minute off of an assist from sophomore MF Holly Schaefer ... Junior GK Ashleigh Dunsmore posted her second shutout of the season while recording three saves ... Mound and Schaefer each have a pair of goals and assists to lead the Tomcats in points with six ...
