The Tomcats notched a goal with just 12:08 left to play to get the victory ... Bethany then fell at Pitt Greensburg by a score of 10-1, and at home to W&J, 9-1 ... Senior **Carissa Moore** scored the goal against Pitt Greensburg in her first game of the season, while junior **Pennie Thomas** tallied a goal against the Presidents.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents split a pair of PAC contests last week as they fell at home to Grove City Tuesday (4-1), but bounced back to rout Bethany, 9-1, Saturday ... The Lady Wolverines broke open a 1-1 tie with 26 minutes left on Tuesday with three-straight goals ... Freshman D Autumn Meredith score her first collegiate goal for W&J off an assist from freshman MF Elizabeth Monzi ... Sophomore GK Marguerite Egan took the loss after making five saves ... Junior MF Toni Lynn Simonini scored two goals and added two assists in Saturday's triumph ... Junior F Jen Pergola and freshman F Marie Majkut also scored ... Freshman GK Alicia Denne recorded her first collegiate win after playing the first 30 minutes.

## Grove City Wolverines

Grove City split a pair of conference matches on the road last week ... Thursday's loss at Westminster snapped the Wolverines' 17-game unbeaten streak (16-0-1) against PAC foes in the regular season ... Stacey Brubaker scored twice at Washington and Jefferson while Michelle Novosel and Autumn Hubbard both scored once in the win ... Westminster out-shot Grove City, 24-6, Thursday in New Wilmington as the Lady Titans picked up a 4-0 win over Grove City ... Sophomore goalkeeper Kori Koper stopped five shots against Westminster ... Four of Grove City's next five matches are at home, with the lone road match in that span at Thiel Oct. 13.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg women's soccer team failed to counter an early goal against Thiel in its lone game this week ... The game featured only 15 shot attempts, the same number of attempts the Yellow Jackets took in their conference win last week against Bethany ... Jackets **Jackie Sassaman** and **Morgan Smoke** tried to get the Waynesburg offense on the board, as each attempted two shots ... Waynesburg goalkeeper **Emily Byers** made five saves in the loss ... For the season, the sophomore boasts a 1.46 goals against average and an 85.9 save percentage.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats posted a 2-1 record last week, picking up a pair of victories against PAC opponents ... Thiel earned 1-0 wins at Bethany Monday and at home against Waynesburg Wednesday before falling at home to Westminster 3-0 Sunday ... Senior GK Nicole Drummond has tied the school-record for shutouts in a season with eight (Sarah Morrison in 2000)
