W&J, TMC AT THE TOP: With three conference contests completed, only defending PAC champion Washington & Jefferson and Thomas More remain unbeaten in league play at 3-0 ... The Presidents posted a 2-0 home decision vs. Westminster before blanking Saint Vincent 3-0 on the road Sunday for their seventh straight win ... The Saints rolled past Grove City (4-1) and Chatham (6-0) ... W&J's **Chrissy Marcus** led NCAA Division III in assists per game (1.0 apg) through games of October 2.

NEWS & NOTES: Junior M **Grace Rieman** scored twice in the opening half to lead Grove City to a 5-1 PAC win over Waynesburg Saturday ... Thomas More senior GK **Katie Burger** allowed just one goal and made four saves in a pair of TMC victories vs. PAC opponents last week ... Senior M **Samantha Killmeyer** of Westminster scored just seconds before the end of the first OT period to lift the Titans past rival Geneva 2-1 ... Bethany outscored two PAC foes 7-1 behind the play of senior D **Breane Minardi**.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: W&J's **Holly Shipley** had a goal and two assists for the 2-0 Presidents ... Senior **Courtney Ebersole** had five points on the week (one goal, three assists) for 1-1 Waynesburg ... **Monika Derboghossian** scored the game-winning goal for Saint Vincent vs. Geneva ... **Risa Tillman** scored the lone goal for Geneva in a 2-1 OT loss to rival Westminster Saturday ... Freshman M **Megan Hardgrove** scored the long goal for Thiel in a 4-1 PAC loss to Bethany Saturday.

Bethany Bison (6-5, 2-1 PAC)

Bethany sandwiched PAC victories around a non-conference loss at Ursuline last week ... The Bison held Chatham without a shot attempt and used a pair of **Cassie Spalding** goals to take a 3-0 victory over the Cougars ... **Paige Prato** also scored in the BC triumph ... In the Thiel win, **Colleen McNurlen** struck for the initial goal just 2:13 into the match ... Spalding then scored three straight, her sixth career hat trick, and a late Tomcat goal just made it a 4-1 final ... Spalding is now tied for the PAC lead with 13 goals and ranks second in points with 30 ... **Brittany Sadler**, who was credited with the shutout against Chatham, made one save against Thiel in 67 minutes before **Jordan Bro** played the final 23 minutes.



Chatham Cougars (1-9, 0-3 PAC)

Chatham fell to 0-3 in PAC play with a 3-0 loss to Bethany and a 6-0 defeat at the hands of Thomas More.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes (4-8-1, 0-3 PAC)

The Geneva women's soccer team has dropped three straight and six of its last seven matches ... The Golden Tornadoes have come close to picking up their first PAC victory but have come up short each time ... Most recently, Geneva dropped a 2-1 overtime decision to Westminster Saturday ... **Risa Tillman** tied the game with her second goal of the season in the first half, but the Titans found the net just seconds before the end of the first overtime session ... The loss dropped Geneva to 4-8-1 overall and 0-3 in conference play ... The Golden Tornadoes will host Bethany on Wednesday before heading to Thomas More next Saturday afternoon.



Grove City Wolverines (4-5-2, 2-1 PAC)

Grove City 1-1 in PAC action last week, closing the week with a 5-1 win over visiting Waynesburg at College Field ... **Grace Rieman** scored twice in the first half for the Wolverines while **Chelsea Tarolli**, **Ashley Sealander** and **Morgan Osterhouse** also scored ... Tarolli and **Lydia Caissy** both had assists ... Grove City outshot the Yellow Jackets 32-9 ... Wednesday, the Wolverines dropped a 4-1 decision at Thomas More ... **Cara Colley** scored the Wolverine goal ... Twelve different Grove City players have scored the team's 20 goals this year ... Eighteen different Grove City players have started a match ... Grove City has 198 all-time victories in 20 years of intercollegiate play.



Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-6-1, 1-2 PAC)

Saint Vincent picked up its first PAC win of the season this week when it topped Geneva, 1-0, on Wednesday ... Sophomore **Monika Derbogossian** recorded her first goal of the season just 12:23 into the match to give the Bearcats the early lead, and eventually, the victory ... Senior **Carly Duffy** picked up the assist on the goal, her first of the season ... Against the Presidents, SVC fell behind just over four-and-a-half minutes into the match before dropping an eventual 3-0 decision on Homecoming weekend.



Thiel Tomcats (4-8-2, 0-3 PAC)

Last week, the women's soccer team fell to Waynesburg University by the score of 5-0 and to Bethany College 4-1 ... In the Bethany game, the lone goal came in the 71st minute from freshman M **Megan Hardgrove**, her first goal of the season.



Thomas More Saints (6-3, 3-0 PAC)

Thomas More extended its win streak to four matches as the Saints defeated Grove City and Chatham last week ... Senior F **Lauren Wietmarschen** led the Saints in scoring with six points on two goals and two assists, while junior M **Chrissy Sonderman** had two goals and an assist for five points ... Senior GK **Katie Burger** played all 180 minutes in goal as she recorded four saves and one shutout and allowed only one goal ... For the season, sophomore F **Courtney Clark** and freshman M **Sam Work** lead the team in scoring with 14 points each on six goals and two assists ... Burger has a 46-3 career record in goal and has 27 saves and four shutouts.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents (9-3, 3-0 PAC)

W&J ran its win streak to seven with wins over Westminster and Saint Vincent last week ... The Presidents have six shutouts during their seven-game winning streak ... The 2010 Presidents set the school record for longest win streak when racking up eight consecutive victories ... W&J is tied for fourth in Division III with eight shutouts this season ... Sophomore **Holly Shipley** scored a goal and added two assists at Saint Vincent on Sunday and also had an assist against Westminster ... Heading into last week's matches, junior **Chrissy Marcus** led Division III in assists per game at 1.00 and was second with 10 assists.

Senior GK **Katrina Kelly** notched her sixth shutout of the year in the victory ... Ebersole continued to rack up the points at Grove City when she tallied her team-leading 13th goal of the season.
