PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER 2009 - Week 8 Conference Notes

A WEEK OF FIRSTS: Bethany won its first PAC match last week with a 1-0 victory over Thiel ... For the first time this season, the Geneva women's soccer team suffered a winless week ... No. 25 Thomas More suffered its first loss of the season in a nonconference match against No. 20 Denison ... Key games heading into this week include W&J versus Thomas More on Wednesday and W&J against Westminster and Grove City at Thomas More on Saturday.

NEWS & NOTES: Heading into last week, Thomas More, as a team, was ranked in the Top 15 in four of five NCAA statistic categories ... Thiel's Jill Harry was ranked in the Top 25 for save percentage early last week ... As a team, Grove City leads the PAC in points (10.25/g), goals (3.5/game), goals per game (3.50/g), assists (3.25/g) and assists per game (3.25/g) in games against conference opponents ... Grove City also leads the PAC in shots (305 total) in all games played.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thomas More GK Jenna Kramer is ranked in the Top 10 in two categories in the NCAA national statistics ... The W&j offense has been paced by a pair of underclassmen at 12 points apiece as sophomore Elizabeth Bendick's 6 goals and freshman Chrissy Marcius' 5 goals and 2 assists ... Thiel's Jill Harry is ranked No. 24 in save percentage nationally and ranked first in the PAC in the same category (.903) and in saves with 11.67 per game.

Bethany Bison (7-6-2, 1-2 PAC)

After falling to Grove City in a hard-fought match Tuesday, the Bison beat Thiel 1-0 for their first league triumph of the season ... Against GCC, Bethany


was able to come back from a pair of one-goal deficit, but a Wolverine score with 11:08 to play was the difference in a 3-2 decision ... BC goals came from **Loren McAnany** off an assist from **Julie Lindenfelser** and **Cassie Spalding** scored off a set-up from **Jen Gallo** ... In the Thiel win, Spalding moved into a tie for the league lead in goals with her 11th of the season in the 70th minute, which was all Bethany needed in a 1-0 victory ... **Brittany Sadler** was credited with her fourth clean sheet of the year.

Chatham Cougars (4-8, 1-4 PAC)

Chatham was defeated in both of its Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) match-ups this week, first on the road at Waynesburg and then at home to visiting #25 Thomas More ... **Ashley Kostial** scored the only goal for the Cougars this week in the match against Waynesburg ... With this goal, she broke the school record for most goals in a season with 10.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (7-6)

For the first time this season, the Geneva women's soccer team suffered a winless week ... The Golden Tornadoes dropped a 3-0 decision to W & J before falling 2-1 to Westminster in overtime ... On Friday



Grove City Wolverines (6-5-3, 4-0 PAC)

Grove City's mid-season surge continued as the Wolverines earned two conference wins last week ... Tuesday night, sophomore **Morgan Osterhouse** scored her first game-winning goal at 78:52 to give the Wolverines a 3-2 win at Bethany ... **Hannah Yang** and **Grace Rieman** both scored goals while **Michelle Peck** assisted on two scores ... Saturday, Grove City blanked Waynesburg as senior GK **Bethany Preston** earned her 16th career win ... Peck and **Emily Ostlund** both had a goal and an assist in the win while Elise Bender also scored ... Preston and **Keri Ketcham** combined for the shutout, Grove City's fourth of the season.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (3-12)

The Bearcats went 0-2 on the week, suffering shut out losses to Westminster (Monday) and Washington & Jefferson (Sunday) ... In the Westminster contest, the Bearcats gave up goals early on in each half, and were unable to recover ... **Kirstie Mills** made nine saves in the losing effort, as SVC was out-shot 16-5 ... The offense continued to struggle against W&J on Sunday, again managing just five shots ... Mills was again strong, posting 11 saves, her fifth double-digit save performance of the season.

Thiel Tomcats (2-11-2, 0-4 PAC)

Thomas More scored the game-winning goal in overtime as the 25th-ranked Saints defeated Thiel, 1-0, in a Presidents' Athletic Conference women's soccer match at The Bank of Kentucky Field ... Thiel dropped its eleventh game of the season, 0-1, to the Bison of Bethany on Saturday... Junior GK Jill Harry combined for 27 stops on the week ... The Tomcats return to action Tuesday, Oct. 20 for a 4 p.m. matchup against the Westminster Titans at Alumni Stadium.

Thomas More Saints (13-1, 4-0 PAC)

The 25^{th} -ranked Thomas More women's soccer team went 2-1 last week as it defeated PAC foes Thiel and Chatham, but fell to 20^{th} -ranked Denison

... The Saints outshot their three opponents last week 83-36 ... Senior F **Deanna Gosdigian** led the Saints offense as she scored two goals ... Defensively, senior GK **Jenna Kramer** played 259:51 and recorded 11 saves and posted a 2-1 record as she recorded one shutout ... In last week's NCAA Division III National Statistical Rankings, Kramer was ranked third in save percentage (0.946) and sixth in goals-against average (0.273) ... For the season the Saints have outshot their opponents, 29-133, including 140-64 on goal.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (7-5-2, 2-1 PAC)


