Mangis scored the game-winning goal in both of W&J's two PAC victories last week, a 2-0 win over Thiel and a 2-1 overtime victory over Waynesburg. Her goal against the Yellow Jackets with 7:55 to play in the second overtime gave the Presidents' their first two-game win streak this season.

Also nominated was sophomore goalkeeper **Leondra Thomas** of Bethany and sophomore forward **Meg Tilley** of Grove City.

# PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES

### **Bethany Bison**

The tough stretch for the Bison continued, as the losing streak grew to nine games with losses to Grove City (4-1) and Westminster (7-1) ... Goalkeeper **Leondra Thomas** was outstanding in the two losses, making 24 saves against Grove City and 23 against Westminster ... **Erica Jackson** scored Bethany's goal against the Wolverines, while **Megan Maloney** found the back of the net in the Westminster loss.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents have turned around a rough start and currently own a two-game winning streak for the first time this season ... W&J has won four of its last six contests, including three of its last four PAC matchups ... Two of W&J's wins this season have come in overtime with goals by the **Mangis**' sisters, **Quinn** and **Hillary**, ending it for the Presidents ... Freshman goalkeeper **Gretchen Weber** of Verona, Pa., has played solid all season for Washington & Jefferson and was 16th in the country in saves per game heading into last week.

## **Grove City Wolverines**

The Lady Wolverines ran their winning streak to a school-record eight games before losing to Frostburg State last Friday, 1-0 ... Grove City earned the No. 1 seed and right to host the 2001 PAC Championship Tournament with its 4-1 victory over Bethany ... The Lady Wolverines polished off a perfect 8-0 league slate with a 2-1 overtime win over Thiel as junior **Katie Wray** netted the gamewinner off a corner kick from **Danielle Balliet** ... Grove City outshot Bethany and Thiel, 73-7 ... GCC will be seeking its second straight PAC title and fifth overall this weekend.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg dropped games to Westminster (8-2) and Washington & Jefferson (2-1 in overtime) last week ... **Lisa Juskowich** is four goals shy of 100 for her career.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped PAC contests to W&J (2-0) and Grove City (2-1) before earning non-conference forfeit win over Chtham last week.

## Westminster Titans

The Westminster women's soccer team posted a 2-1 week, sandwiching wins over PAC rivals Waynesburg (8-2) and Bethany (7-1) around a 3-2 non-conference loss to Allegheny ... Sophomore Megan Chovan posted a pair of goals against Waynesburg, while junior Erin Quinlan added a goal and two assists ... Senior Ashley Pyle and junior Tammy Newell scored Westminster's goals in the loss to Allegheny ... Bethany and Westminster were tied 1-1 early in the second half before the Lady Titans rattled off six unanswered goals ... Ashley Pyle had a pair of goals at Bethany, giving her a team-high 19 goals this year and extending her school record for career goals to 74.
