# KATIE KLINGENSMITH Grove City College

Junior midfielder Wexford, Pa./Pine-Richland H.S.

Klingensmith posted a school-record five assists for GCC in a 6-0 win over Thiel, which clinched the top seed in the PAC Tournament for the Lady Wolverines. She also scored a goal earlier in the week in a 10-1 win at Bethany.

Also nominated was sophomore MF **Rachel Moses** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman F **Olivia Wilkerson** of Westminster.

### PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES

### Bethany Bison

Bethany wrapped up the regular season with two losses at home last week to Grove City (10-1) and Westminster (4-0) ... Bethany's goal against the Wolverines came from the foot of junior Pennie Thomas in the 86<sup>th</sup> minute ... It was her teamleading fourth goal and eighth point of the season ... Grove City scored just 20 seconds into the game and never looked back as 10 different players notched a goal ... Against the Titans, BC was outshot 27-4, with all four shots coming from Thomas ... The game was called in the 75th minutes because of poor field conditions due to rain ... Bethany GK Jess Alloggia came up with 12 saves in the contest.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents, who are 6-1-1 in their last eight matches, recorded conference wins over Thiel and Waynesburg this past week ... Sophomore MF Rachel Moses and freshman MF Kallen Frey scored firsthalf goals in the 4-0 shutout of Thiel Wednesday ... Moses started the scoring in the 35th minute as she lofted a shot past TC junior goalie Ashleigh Dunsmore ... Junior F Jen Pergola and freshman D Autumn Meredith assisted on the goal ... W&J held the one-goal advantage until Frey broke through the Tomcat defense and scored with 22 seconds remaining in the half ... Pergola and freshman F Emily Cottrill netted goals in the second half ... The Presidents out-shot the Tomcats by a 27-0 margin.

### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City clinched home-field advantage throughout the PAC Tournament with a 6-0 win over Thiel Saturday ... Junior Katie Klingensmith set a school singlematch record with five assists in the win ... Senior Michelle Novosel scored twice in the first eight minutes to ignite the Grove City offense ... Klingensmith now has 11 assists this season, two way from Novosel's single-season record of 13 in 2003 ... Kori Koper earned the shutout in goal, the Wolverines' 10th shutout of the season ... Ten different Grove City players scored in a 10-1 win at Bethany Tuesday ... Stacey Brubaker, Maia Siber and Becky Iden each had a goal and an assist ... Grove City is 23-0-1 in its last 24 October matches.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College women's soccer team was handily defeated against Westminster 8-0 on Tuesday, before returning to action to take a one-goal lead on Saturday against Washington & Jefferson, only to have the lead slip away, losing 4-1 ... Senior midfielder **Jackie Sassaman** netted her team-leading 10th goal in the loss to the Presidents and now has a career-high 31 points this season.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished the regular season losing eight of their last nine as the fell on the road to W&J on Wednesday (0-4) and Grove City on Saturday (0-6) ... The fifthseeded Tomcats will travel to fourthseeded Waynesburg College Tuesday to compete in the opening round of the PAC Championship Tournament.

#### Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans closed the 2004 regular season with a pair of decisive PAC shutout wins, topping Waynesburg (8-0) and Bethany (4-0) ... Eight different players scored vs. Waynesburg ... Leading the way was sophomore F Sarah Calderone, who posted a goal and two assists, while four other players - sophomore M Courtney Thompson and freshman forwards Scarlett Bretz, Andrea Michalenko and Olivia Wilkerson each posted a goal and an assist ... Senior Laura Vollmer and freshman Tara Merrill split the shutout in goal, with each making one save ... At Bethany, Wilkerson, sophomore F Christa Andamasaris, senior M Melissa Schroder and freshman D Kristen Martin each scored for Westminster.
