PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER 2010 - Week 9 Conference Notes

TOURNEY TIME: The 2010 PAC Women's Soccer Championship Tournament gets underway on Wednesday (Nov. 3) with a pair of semifinal matches ... PAC regular season champion and unbeaten (14-0-3) Thomas More is the top seed and will host #4 Westminster at 2 p.m., while two-time defending PAC champion Washington & Jefferson is the second seed and will host #3 Grove City at 7 p.m. ... The top remaining seed will host the title match Saturday at a time TBA.

NEWS & NOTES: Waynesburg (10-6-3) finished the season with the most wins for the Yellow Jackets in a season since 2001, while posting the program's first winning record since before 2001 ... Bethany senior F **Cassie Spalding** became just the fifth Bison to reach 100 career points with two goals and an assist at Chatham ... Junior M **Sara Harrison** scored the game-winning goal in overtime for Thomas More at Grove City Saturday ... **Catherine Czapski** scored the OT game-winner for Saint Vincent in a 1-0 win at Geneva.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior Fs **Hannah Yang** of Grove City and **Sarah Nee** of Westminster each scored three goals last week to finish the season with 16 goals apiece ... Freshman **Holly Shipley** had a goal and an assist for W&J at Westminster ... Multiple injuries forced Chatham to play shorthanded in season-ending PAC losses to Grove City and Bethany ... Geneva closed the season with losses in six of its final seven contests after a 9-1-3 start ... Thiel lost eight one-goal games this season.

Bethany Bison (8-8-2, 3-4-1 PAC)



The Bison were eliminated from PAC Tournament contention with a 4-1 loss to Westminster Wednesday ... The Titans scored 42 seconds into the match and added two goals before halftime ... **Cassie Spalding** scored in the 60th minute, but BC couldn't muster another score ... Bethany closed out the season with a 12-0 win over Chatham Saturday, the most goals by BC since 1990 ... **Lisa Wabrick** registered a hat trick with three goals and added two assists ... **Cassie Spalding** wrapped up her second straight PAC scoring crown with two goals and an assist, which also made her just the fifth Bison player to reach 100 career points ... **Alaina Heck** and **Julie Lindenfelser** also each had two goals and one assist.

Chatham Cougars (4-14, 1-7 PAC)



The Cougars completed their regular season schedule this week with Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) losses to both Grove City and Bethany ... Both losses were shut-out losses for Chatham, who was held scoreless in their final eight games of the season (all losses) ... The Cougars finished 4-14 overall this season and 1-7 in PAC play with a win over Thiel College.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (10-7-3)



It was a frustrating end to the women's soccer season Saturday ... Outplaying Saint Vincent for most of the night, the Golden Tornadoes watched the Bearcats score the only goal of the game three minutes into the second OT period to steal a 1-0 victory ... Despite the efforts of senior GK **Lauren Londino**, Geneva was unable to find the net despite several outstanding chances ... It was another scoreless week for the GTs as they dropped a 1-0 decision to Waynesburg earlier in the week ... Geneva finished the regular season at 10-7-3 including shut-out losses in six of the last seven matches ... The GTs have qualified for the NCCAA regional tournament.

Grove City Wolverines (11-7, 5-3 PAC)



Grove City wrapped up the regular season last week by going 1-1 in PAC play ... Thursday, Grove City downed an unmanned Chatham squad at College Field ... **Arielle Goyzueta** posted her first career hat trick ... **Grace Rieman** scored twice and assisted on a third goal ... **Morgan Osterhouse** also scored twice ... **Julie Apple** assisted on three goals ... **Tiffany Yost** and **Bekan Van Eerden** combined for the shutout in goal ... Van Eerden also scored a goal ... Saturday on Senior Day, Grove City fell in overtime to Thomas More 2-1 ... Yang gave Grove City a 1-0 lead in the first half ... Rieman has a PAC-high 12 assists ... The Wolverines' 69 goals this year are the program's most since the 2002 team scored 73 goals.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-10-3, 3-5 PAC)



The Bearcats went 1-1 on the week, falling 1-0 at PAC leader Thomas More on Wednesday before picking up a dramatic double-overtime win at Geneva on Saturday night ... Wednesday, the Bearcats were out-shot 23-3 for the game, but the team's defense, led by goalie **Kirstie Mills**, kept the game close, as she finished with 11 saves, including a stop on a penalty kick midway through the second half ... In Beaver Falls on Saturday, **Catherine Czapski** scored the game-winner with seven minutes left in the second overtime to break a scoreless tie ... Mills earned her fourth shutout of the season, finishing with seven stops.

Thiel Tomcats (2-17, 0-8 PAC)



The Thiel College women's soccer team finished the week with 0-2 record ... The Tomcats were defeated by W & J 5-0 and then defeated by Waynesburg 1-0 ... The loss to the Yellow Jackets marks the eighth one goal loss this season.

Thomas More Saints (14-0-3, 8-0 PAC)



The Saints earned their highest national ranking in program history as they were ranked No. 20 in last week's NSCAA/HendrickCars.com Top-25 ... Thomas More clinched the outright PAC regular season and the No. 1 seed in the PAC Championship Tournament last week as it defeated Saint Vincent, 1-0, and Grove City, 2-1, in overtime ... Senior M **Megan Keck** scored the game-winning goal in the win against Saint Vincent, while freshman F **Courtney Clark** scored the game-tying goal against Grove City and junior M **Sara Harrison** scored the game-winning goal against the Wolverines ... Junior goalkeeper **Katie Burger** played 143:22 in goal last week and recorded three saves.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (13-5, 7-1 PAC)



W&J finished off its regular season with a 2-0 week ... The Presidents' seven PAC wins are a new school record ... Freshman **Cheyenne Mangold** led the Presidents with two goals and one assist in a 5-0 victory over Thiel Wednesday ... Sophomore **Chrissy Marcus** scored a goal, her eighth on the season, to give her 14 for her career ... She is one goal away from eighth place on W&J's all-time goals list ... Freshman **Holly Shipley** led the Presidents with a goal and an assist in W&J's 3-1 win over Westminster Saturday ... Shipley now has a team-high 34 points on the season ... Sophomore **Dawn Murphy** and freshman **Bianca Rajan** added goals.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (10-6-3, 3-4-1 PAC)



The Waynesburg women's soccer team didn't allow a goal over two games this week and ended the 2010 season on a five-game unbeaten streak ...
