Bethany Bison

Bethany split a pair of matches against PAC teams last week and sit at 5-5 on the year ... The Bison swept the doubles matches against W&J, while Katie Navarra, Hillary Norman, Lindsay Caparese and Beth Wichrowski won in singles ... Navarra and Norman also won in singles against Westminster, but the other four spots lost and Bethany dropped tow of three in doubles to lose for the second time this year to Westminster.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson dropped a 7-2 match to Bethany on Tuesday afternoon in Bethany, W.Va. ... Junior **Denise Lattner** claimed her No. 5 singles match, 6-2, 6-1, while sophomore **Jennifer Van Gorder** defeated Bethany's **Sami Kennedy**, 7-5, 6-3, at No. 3 singles to give the Presidents their only two points in the match ... Washington & Jefferson concludes its regular-season schedule on Wednesday by hosting Division II California (Pa.) at 3:00 pm at the Swanson Tennis Courts.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City ran its conference winning streak to 65 with a win at Westminster, completing a perfect conference season ... Against Westminster, the Lady Wolverines swept the singles matches as Allison Atwood, Lisa Oriti, Erika Hauge, Megan Hulick, Nicole Leasure and Julie Crewson all won ... Atwood and Crewson were GCC's lone winners against Division II West Liberty last Thursday ... Several Grove City players participated in the ITA Southeast Regionals in Fredericksburg, Va. Sept. 28-30 ... Atwood and Oriti both went 1-1 while Hauge and Hulick were each 1-2 ... The team of Atwood-Oriti went 1-2 in doubles action.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg bounced back from a tough 5-4 loss at Penn State-Altoona on Tuesday to defeat Thiel 9-0 on Wednesday ... On Tuesday, the No. 1 doubles team of **Andrea Custer** and **Mindy Hall** avenged an early season loss by topping Altoona's **Obermier** and **Barton** 8-4 ... It wasn't enough, however, as close matches at third doubles (7-9) and fourth singles (6-1, 0-6, 3-6) went the Cougars direction to pull out the match ... On Wednesday, the Jackets won at every position to move to 2-3 in the conference.

Thiel finished last week 0-3 ... The Tomcats match against Pitt-Greensburg on Saturday was canceled due to bad weather ...
