# PAC CROSS COUNTRY NOTES

#### **Bethany Bison**

Both Bethany teams posted solid efforts at the Thiel Invitational Saturday ... The men finished fifth, led by freshman Ken Hopper, who placed seventh overall with a time of 28:58 ... Two more freshmen placed in the top 30, including Kevin McGann (25th) and Mike Reese (27th) ... On the women's side, the Bison claimed sixth place ... Junior Tiffany Baumgart was the top runner for Bethany, crossing in 15th place (27:02) ... Freshman Mallory Roadman was just behind Baumgart in 16th place, just six seconds off ... Freshman Alexis Rimfred gave the Bison three top 25 performances with a 24th place finish.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The W&J men's squad was led at Thiel by senior **Matt Yokitis**, who finished 21st with a time of 30:25 ... Fellow senior **Aaron Sontz** placed 35th overall (32:59), while junior **Byron Johnson** finished close behind in 36th place (33:01) ... The W&J women competed on an individual basis due to a small squad, however, freshman **Alexis Orchowski** improved upon her 21st-place showing last week at Muskingum by finishing 17th overall in a time of 27:13.

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

GCC opened season with solid performances in both events at Case Western Reserve ... Freshman Elisa Pedersen led the Lady Wolverines with a second-place finish (19:29) while sophomore Janna Sallade placed seventh (19:44), helping Grove City finish third ... Katherine Muse added a 23<sup>rd</sup>-place arrival in 22:38 ... On the men's side, junior Steve Brown came home 13<sup>th</sup> in 27:59 while senior Ryan Mitchell was 17<sup>th</sup> in 28:09.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Chrissy Barnhart was Waynesburg's top finisher in the Thiel College Cross Country Invitational on Sept. 7 ... Barnhart recorded a time of 28:23 to place 26th overall to lead the Yellow Jackets to a seventh place finish in the nine-team field ... Freshman Michelle Thompson trailed Barnhart by 19 seconds with a time of 28:42 to finish 31st overall ... Waynesburg's top runner from last week, sophomore Rachel Feldner, was plagued by an injury in the first half mile of the race.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel College men's and women's cross country squads hosted the Thiel College Invitational last Saturday ... The men finished 7th with 188 points, while the women took 5th with 121 points ... Freshman Ben Wheeler was the top runner on the men's side, finishing in 31st place with a time of 31:56 ... Freshman Brandon Shemack finished in 39th place with a time of 33:14 ... Sophomore MaryBeth Scialabba was the top Tomcat women's performer, placing fourth with a time of 25:36, setting a new school mark with her finish ... Junior Mayumi Sasaki finished in 22nd place (27:46), followed by freshman Jacci Corso who placed 25th with a time of 28:11.

#### Westminster Titans

The Westminster cross country teams each competed at the nine-team Thiel Invitational, with the men placing second and the women finishing third ... The Titan men placed a pair of runners in the top six overall, as junior **Sean Gallagher** led all PAC runners with a fourth place finish in 28:44 and senior **Dan Beckwith** finished sixth in 28:50 ... The Lady Titan harriers placed two runners in the top eight overall, as junior **Sara lalongo** placed sixth in 26:10 and senior **Nicole Beaver** was eighth in 26:34.
