Spaulding captured the invitational title at the California (Pa.) Invitational Saturday, covering

the 8K course in 27:36.20 to best 77 other runners, including numerous Division II runners. He helped lead the Wolverines to the team title as well.

The women placed second, as they had three top 10 finishers ... Suzanne Stettinius was their top runner for the second straight week, placing sixth (22:34) ... Following closely was Chantal Stettinius in seventh (23:00) and Emily Roth in eighth (23:05) ... For the men, Clifford Arbogast was the top runner, as he settled for ninth place after getting edged out for eighth by .5 seconds ... Patrick Miller took 14th place overall.

Thomas More Saints

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



Senior Matthew Rudzki and junior Erin Long led their respective squads with runner-up finishes on Saturday at the Ursinus Invitational in Collegeville, Pa.... The women's 5K race

featured 63 runners, while the men's field included 65 competitors ... Rudzki recorded a time of 27:54 to lead the men, while Long paced the W&J women with a time of 20:40 ... Junior **Bobby Regan** placed fourth (28:37), while freshman **Andrew Howard** earned 12th place (30:05) ... Junior **Megan Duffett** earned the top finish of her career after claiming seventh place (21:45) ... Freshman **Laura Procario** placed 28th overall (23:35), while competing in her first collegiate event in her hometown.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

women's team finished third at the eight-team event and was led by junior Megan Grover, who finished the race 12th-overall with a time of 21 minutes 7.20 seconds ... Senior Tim Monaghan led the men's team with a 17th-place finish and a time of 29:04.50 ... The Yellow Jacket men's squad finished sixth in the eight-team field.

Westminster Titans



Westminster competed at the 36th annual California (Pa.) Invitational Saturday ... Sophomore **Elizabeth Beardsley** finished with a 25th-place time of 22:05.70 in the women's 5-kilometer race, followed by teammates sophomore **Amanda Everett** and senior **Leanna Stitt** making the Top

50 with 40th- and 50th-place times of 22:49.20 and 23:31.70 ... Sophomore **Jeremiah Patterson** ran the men's 8-kilometer race in 29:35.90 for 20th place overall to lead the Titan men ... Junior **Andrew Brown**, sophomore **Nate Hunter** and senior **Cory Criss** all cracked the Top 50 at 41st (31:13.10), 48th (31:58.80) and 50th (32:04.10), respectively.
